


Fremont Police Week In Review

Carjacking

On 6/20, officers responded to a supermarket on Warms Springs Blvd to an initial report of a stolen vehicle. The vehicle owner (victim) initially said that the subject asked for a lighter, and when the victim obliged, the subject got into the vehicle and drove away. Officers later learned that the victim was thrown out of his vehicle before the subject took it. The victim was not injured, and the crime was upgraded to carjacking. This case remains under investigation. #230620024

Catalytic Converter Theft

On 6/22, officers responded to Dunbar Place on a report of two subjects tampering with a ring doorbell camera. The subjects stole a catalytic converter from a passenger van. Officers later located the subjects' vehicle near Paseo Padre Pkwy and Peralta Blvd. Officers attempted a stop, but the vehicle fled at a high rate of speed. This case remains under investigation. #230622004

DUI/Possession of a Loaded Firearm

On 6/26, FPD received an automated accident notification on Paseo Padre Parkway and Isherwood Way. An ambulance nearby also witnessed the accident and advised a vehicle crashed into a tree and light pole. Officers arrived and determined the driver to be intoxicated. During a vehicle search, officers found two loaded, unserialized firearms. One adult subject was arrested and transported to the hospital for medical clearance. #230626004

Illegal Gun Possession and Resisting Arrest

On 6/22, the Major Crimes Task Force requested patrol to assist with a perimeter to apprehend a subject near Gina St and Ladner St. The subject was believed to be armed with a handgun and was fleeing arrest by jumping fences and running through backyards and rooftops. Officers quickly contained the subject within their perimeter, and the subject surrendered. A handgun was recovered from one of the residences along the subject's path. #230622016

Shots Fired

On 6/24, FPD received multiple 9-1-1 calls reporting gunshots at an apartment complex on Mowry Ave. Officers arrived on the scene and found shell casings inside the apartment complex at two locations. Bullet impacts were located on the concrete walls of the parking lot. Witnesses described seeing an unknown male subject who appeared to be running away from a passenger vehicle as the vehicle pursued him through the parking lot. The vehicle then fled towards Mowry Avenue. The unknown male subject was last seen running through the apartment complex but was not located. This case remains under investigation. #230624026

Unattended Death

On 6/23, officers responded to Stevenson Blvd and Civic Center Dr to the report of a subject lying under a bench. Moments later, another caller reported the person was covered in blood. Officers arrived and located an unresponsive subject. Officers attempted to render aid; however, the subject was pronounced deceased at the scene. Investigation revealed the subject had recently been discharged from the hospital and appeared to suffer from a medical emergency resulting in his death. There was nothing suspicious and no sign of foul play. The Coroner's Office responded and collected the decedent. #230623010

Other Incidents

On 6/21, officers responded to a bank located on Fremont Blvd regarding a dumpster fire in the parking lot. A subject was located in the area and was positively identified by bank workers as the subject who started the fire. The adult subject out of Fremont was arrested. #230621011

On 6/22, officers responded to the report of a suspicious vehicle circling a residential neighborhood. Officers located the vehicle, made an investigatory stop, and determined the driver to be under the influence of a controlled substance. The driver, an adult subject out of Fremont, was arrested. #230622023

On 6/26, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Decoto Rd to the report of a subject armed with a knife, pointing it at others, and challenging people to fight. The subject also stole from a nearby convenience store prior. After brandishing the knife at restaurant patrons, the subject returned to the convenience store to confront the shopkeeper. Officers arrived on the scene and arrested the subject. #230626035
