DUI Collision

On 7/2, officers responded to the area of Onondaga Dr and Paseo Padre Pkwy after multiple witnesses reported a single-vehicle crash. The involved vehicle flipped onto its roof and caught fire. Several bystanders helped the driver and sole occupant out of his vehicle before it became fully engulfed. Officers arrived and determined the driver to be under the influence. The driver was transported to a regional medical center. This case remains under investigation. #230702028

Felony Battery/Burglary/Vandalism

On 6/30, a female subject attacked the office secretary at a Montessori school near Stevenson Blvd and Paseo Padre Pkwy when the victim confronted her about trespassing on school property in plain view of students. The subject then proceeded to cause damage inside the school's lobby and to employee vehicles before fleeing on foot. Officers located and detained the subject in the area. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was transported to a local hospital for medical clearance before being taken to jail. #230630023

Indecent Exposure

On 7/2, officers responded to a male subject exposing himself on the 39000 block of Argonaut Way. The subject was specifically performing this lewd act in front of a waxing salon and a sandwich shop. The subject was also riding an electric bicycle. A short time later, a nearby resident called to report a similar subject pulling his pants down and exposing himself in the area. Officers arrived on the scene and contacted the subject. A warrant check revealed the subject to be on parole. Officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Fremont, who was highly intoxicated. #230702014

Robbery (Armed)

In the early hours of 6/27, a victim was changing an automobile headlight near Durham Rd and Paseo Padre Pkwy. A vehicle pulled up behind the victim's car, and a male subject approached, produced a handgun, and demanded the victim's wallet, which he gave up. The subject then fled the scene. This case remains under investigation. #230627006

Robbery (Estes)

On 6/27, officers responded to a supermarket on Mowry Ave to an estes robbery. A subject stole food items and was confronted by a store employee. The subject punched the employee, exited the parking lot, and drove off in a vehicle. The store employee was not seriously injured, and the case remains under investigation. #230627036

On 6/30, officers responded to an estes robbery at a gas station on Auto Mall Pkwy. A subject attempted to leave the gas station without paying for items. The clerk confronted the subject, and the subject threatened to fight. The subject then left on a bicycle. Officers arrived and located the subject in the area. The clerk positively identified the subject, an adult out of Fremont, who was arrested. #230630003

Theft/Robbery/Assault

On 6/28, officers responded to a supermarket on Mowry Ave to a report of several subjects taking items and a victim being hit by a car driven away by the subjects. As units converged into the area, officers located the subjects' vehicle and attempted an enforcement stop. The vehicle immediately fled onto the freeway at a high speed. The suspect vehicle ultimately exited off Alvarado Niles Road. Units saturated the area but could not locate the vehicle. The victim in the original matter was not injured, and officers later determined that only the theft occurred. This case remains under investigation. #230628040

Theft/Warrant Service

On 7/1, officers responded to a store at the Fremont Hub regarding a subject loading up a shopping cart with hundreds of dollars worth of toy building blocks and fleeing the store. Store employees provided a vehicle description, and officers were able to locate the vehicle nearby. Officers stopped the vehicle near Mowry Ave and Argonaut Way and identified the subject who stole the toys. The subject had an outstanding warrant. The loss was recovered, and the subject, an adult out of Scotts Valley, was arrested. #230701029
