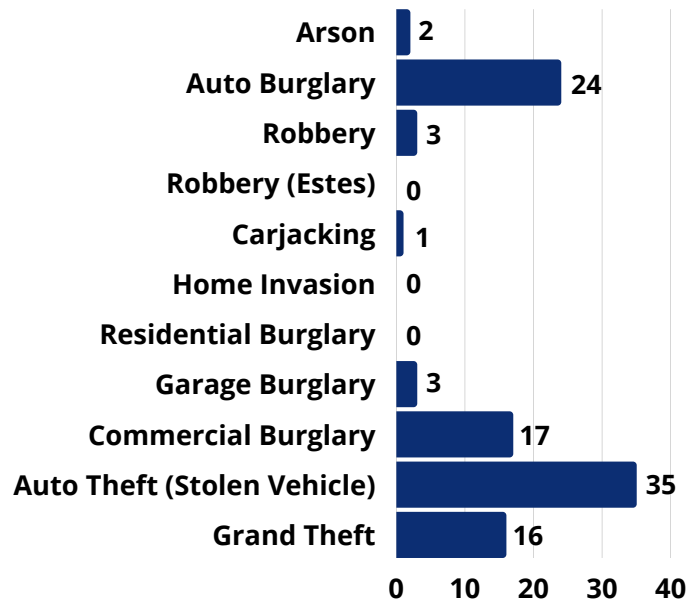




Fremont Police Week In Review

Armed Robbery/Attempted Armed Carjacking

On 8/6, officers responded to a call regarding four armed subjects who had attempted to carjack a driver (victim) on Thornton Ave crossing over I-880. The subjects blocked the front of the victim's car with a stolen car, at which time numerous subjects pointed firearms at the victim and removed her from the vehicle. The subjects were unsuccessful in stealing the vehicle, but stole \$300 from inside the vehicle before fleeing. The case remains under investigation. #230806015

Arson

On 8/1, officers responded to a request from Fremont Fire Department for assistance with a structure fire at an abandoned house on Osgood Rd. A construction worker in the area observed a suspicious person exit the house prior to the fire. FFD extinguished the fire. The case remains under investigation. #230801005

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 8/2, officers responded to a report that two subjects had battered a victim at a fast-food restaurant on Ardenwood Blvd. After a verbal dispute, the subjects began punching the victim and used a sock filled with rocks to beat him. The subjects then fled the area. The case remains under investigation. #230802030

Battery

On 8/2, officers responded to a victim on Webfoot Loop who stated that a subject had threatened to graffiti the home and punched him. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him, an adult out of Union City. #230802038

Felony Battery

On 8/3, officers responded to a report of a fight at a residence on Camino Santa Barbara. The subject battered and bit the victim. Officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Lathrop. #230803003

Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 8/3, officers responded to multiple reports of a subject drinking and trashing an apartment on Central Ave. The subject stripped his clothing and began menacing neighbors in the unit's hallway. Officers detained the subject in the parking lot and put him, an adult out of Fremont, on a mental health hold. #230803037

Robbery/Mental Health Evaluation Hold

On 8/3, officers responded to a report of a subject yelling at herself and potentially in crisis. Another caller reported seeing the subject on top of another individual (victim) on the ground. The subject took the victim's belongings and fled on foot to the Fremont BART station. She became irrational, feigned jumping in front of a BART train, and attempted to kick out the window of a patrol car. Officers detained the subject, an adult out of Fremont, and placed her on a mental health evaluation hold. #230803020

Robbery

On 8/3, officers responded to a victim who said the subject had pushed him off his bicycle and rode off with it on Warren Ave. Officers located the subject, an adult out of Fremont, in front of a bank and arrested him. #230803009

Sexual Battery

On 8/6, a victim reported being approached by a subject who grabbed her and exposed himself to her while walking her dog on S Grimmer Blvd. As officers were speaking with her, dispatch broadcasted an in-progress petty theft, in which the subject matched the description of the subject in this sexual battery. Officers located the subject at a department store on Osgood Rd, and the victim positively identified him. Officers arrested the subject, an adult, out of Fremont. #230806030

Trespassing

On 8/1, an employee from a gas station on Mowry Ave reported that a subject had stolen items, entered the restroom, removed all her clothes, and defecated on the floor. Officers issued the subject a trespass notice. #230801010
