

### **Battery**

On 9/22, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd and Mowry Ave for a large fight involving approximately 30 juveniles. Most of the juveniles fled as police arrived, and no parties were seriously hurt. Officers determined that two people were fighting, but both fled before police arrived. The fight was likely spillover from an event at a nearby high school. #230922030

#### **Brandishing a weapon**

On 9/23, a victim reported that, while he and two other victims were sitting outside a coffee shop on Washington Blvd and Fremont Blvd, a subject in a vehicle had pointed a firearm at the group while stopped at the intersection. The subject drove away, but officers eventually located him with a passenger nearby. Officers found a firearm beside the passenger's side seat, live ammunition, and a spent shell casing. Officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Berkeley, and the passenger, an adult out of Fremont. #230923021

On 9/22, a juvenile victim was getting off a bus at a bus stop near a school on Mowry Ave when a subject accosted her. The subject yelled obscenities at the victim and tried to strike her with a stick. This case remains under investigation. #230922028

## **Home Invasion Robbery**

On 9/20, officers responded to the Stewart Ave and Christy St area for a late reported home invasion robbery and vehicle theft. The victim was asleep in his locked RV when he was awakened by two masked subjects armed with knives. The subjects stole items from his RV and his other vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #230920004

### **Indecent Exposure**

On 9/22, officers responded to an employee at a grocery store on Washington Blvd regarding a subject outside who was exposing himself to customers. The subject left before police arrived, and no victims were located. #P23112524

#### **Outside Assist**

On 9/24, dispatch received multiple phone calls regarding a large explosion heard in the Niles Canyon area. In the area of the suspected explosion, a fire was seen on the hillside. Officers responded alongside Fremont Fire Department units. CAL Fire was already on the scene addressing the moderately sized fire. The source of the fire is unknown, but it may have been a firework. There was no evidence of an arson attempt, and no one was hurt as a result of this incident. #230924019

### Robbery

On 9/22, officers responded to a call regarding a robbery at the Warm Springs BART Station. The subject had called the victim into the elevator, punched him, and threw him to the ground once the victim was inside. The subject continued beating the victim outside the elevator, stealing his wallet and other belongings. The subject fled on foot before officers arrived. The case was forwarded to BART police for follow-up. #230922024

On 9/23, a victim was using the ATM at a bank on Fremont Blvd and Mowry Ave. A subject's vehicle blocked her in, and the subject opened her door and stole her purse by force. The victim was injured during the robbery, and the subject fled in the vehicle before officers arrived. Officers located the subject's vehicle in an apartment complex in a nearby city and found the subject hiding in the area. Multiple purses were found in the vehicle. Officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Oakland. #230923024

### **Trespassing**

On 9/21, officers responded to the 37000 block of Murietta PI regarding a subject in the backyard of a vacant home. The subject was setting garbage on fire. Officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Fremont. #230921012

#### **Unattended Death**

On 9/24, out-of-state family and friends arrived at a residence for a subject they had not been able to reach for several months. Officers responded and made entry into the home, finding the subject to be deceased. There were no signs of foul play, forced entry, or injury on the subject. The Alameda County Sheriff's Office Coroner conducted the death investigation and transported the decedent. #230924017
