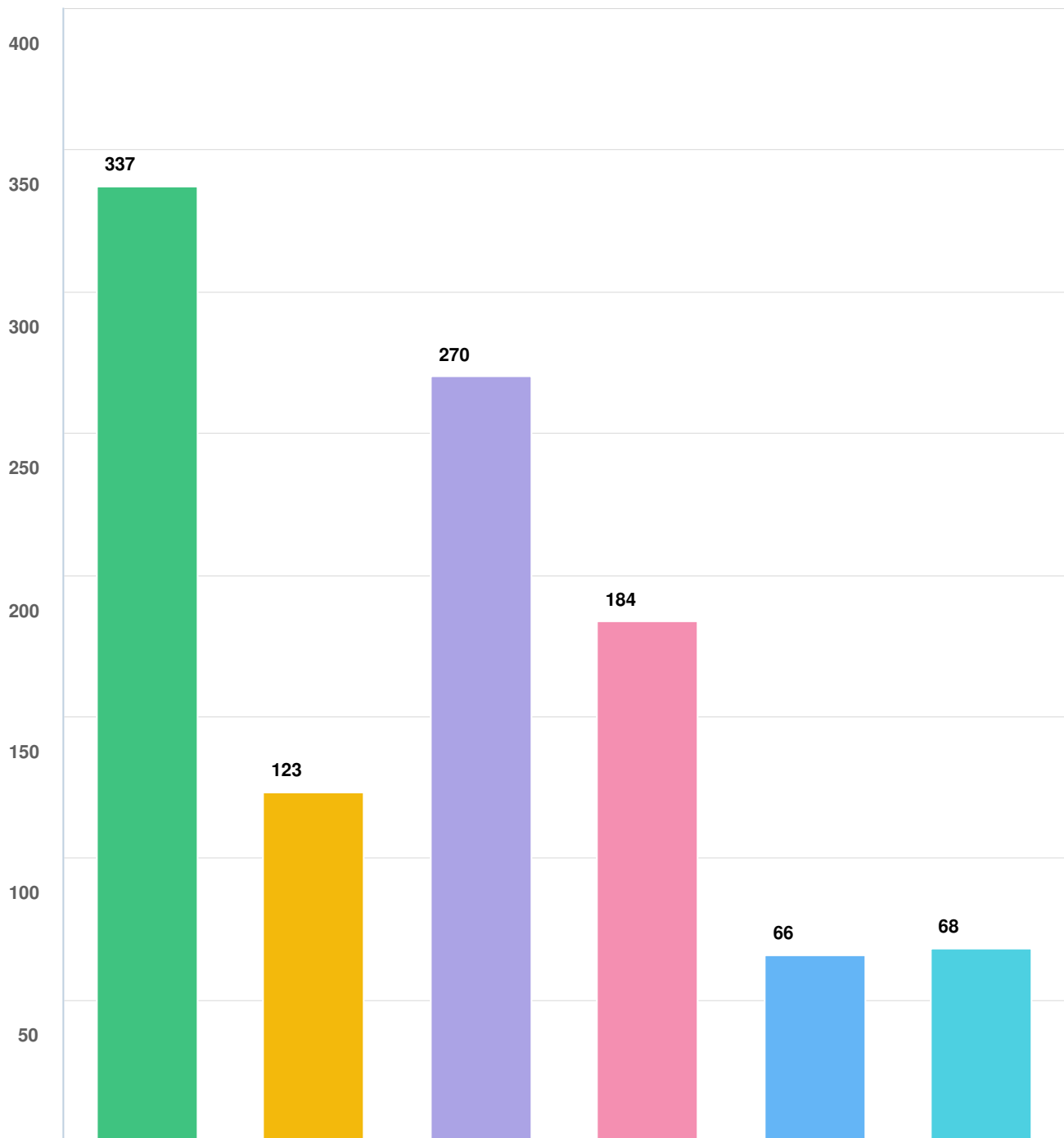

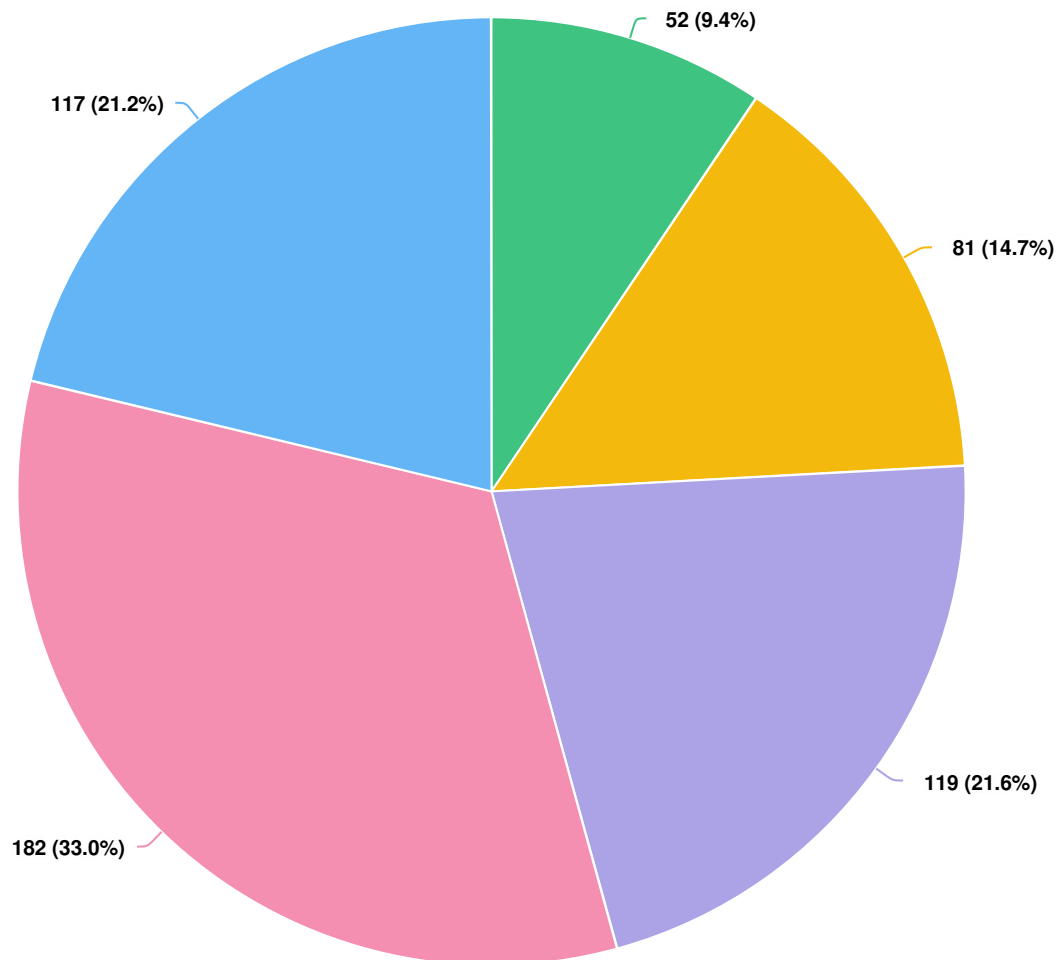

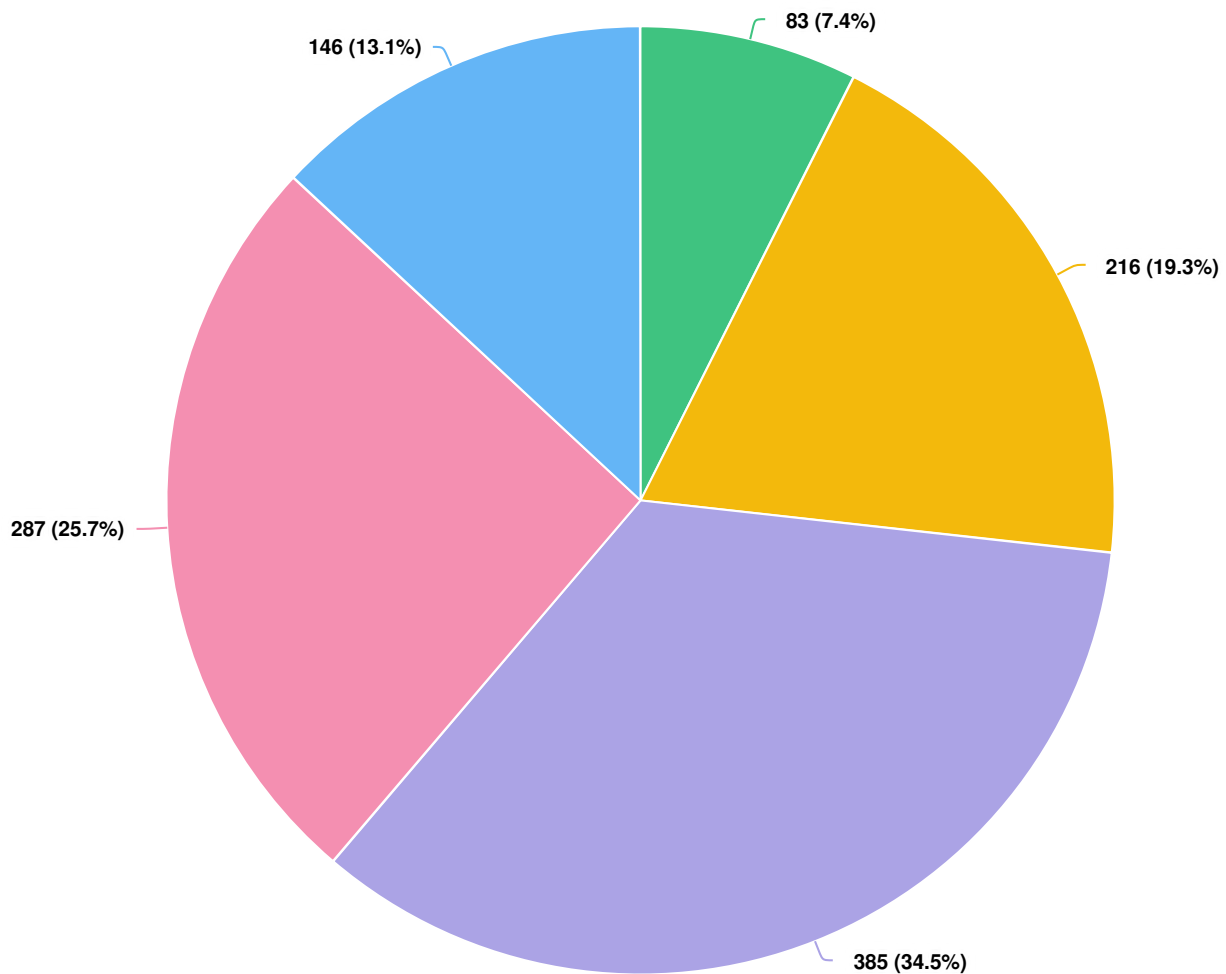

Q4 | Do you feel that Fremont Police Department works together with community members to solve local problems?



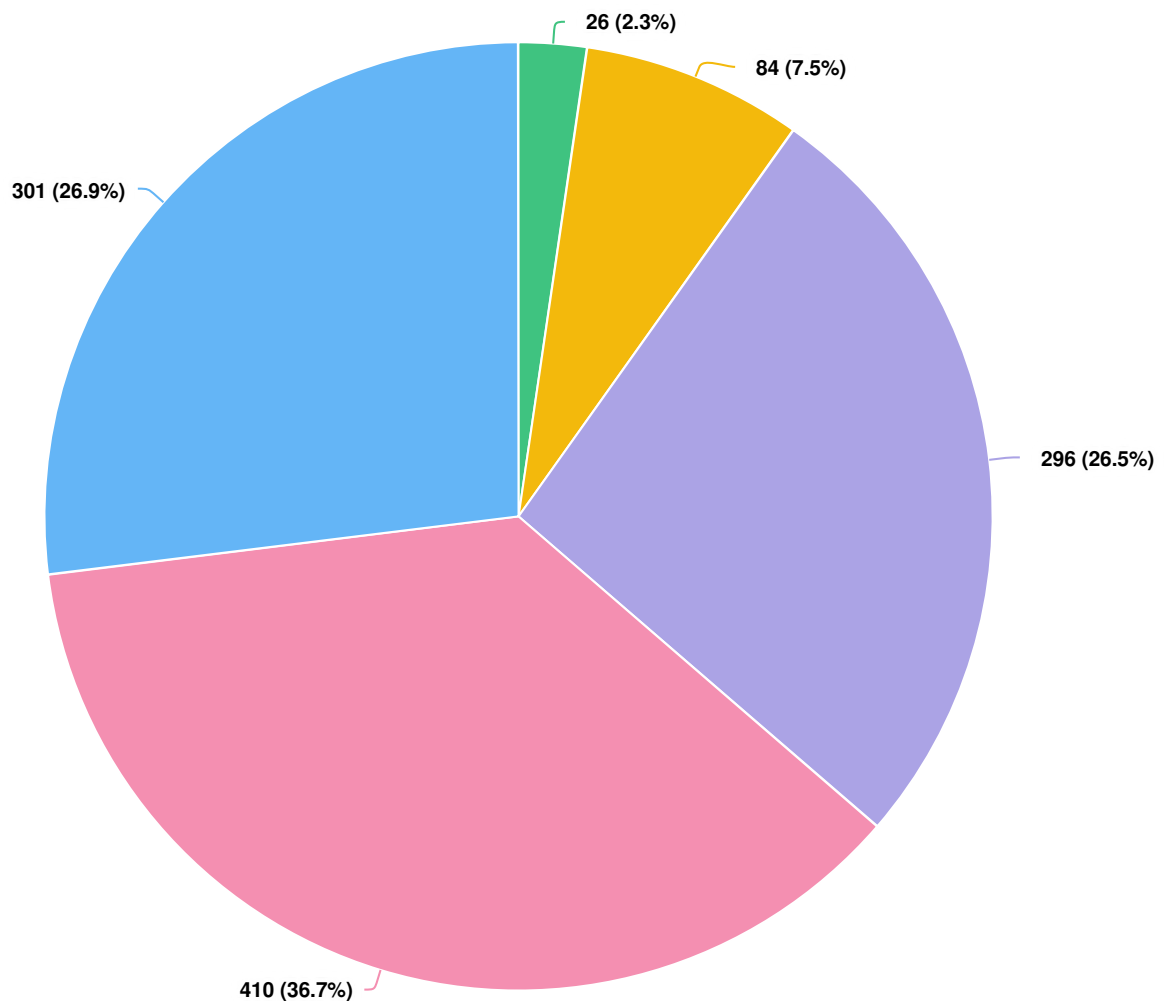

Q5 | Do you feel that Fremont Police Department personnel are courteous, respectful and professional when interacting with you or other community members?

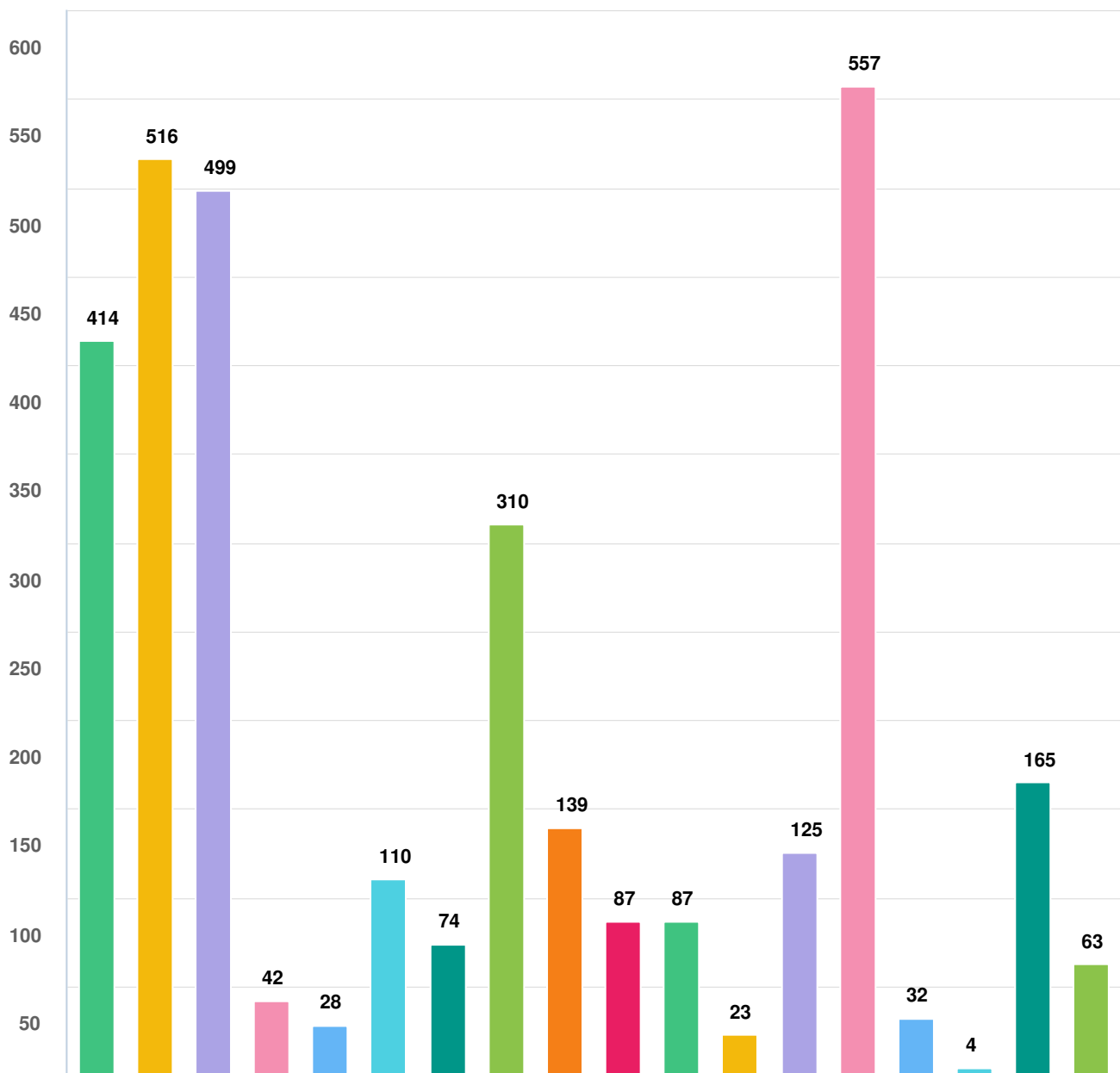

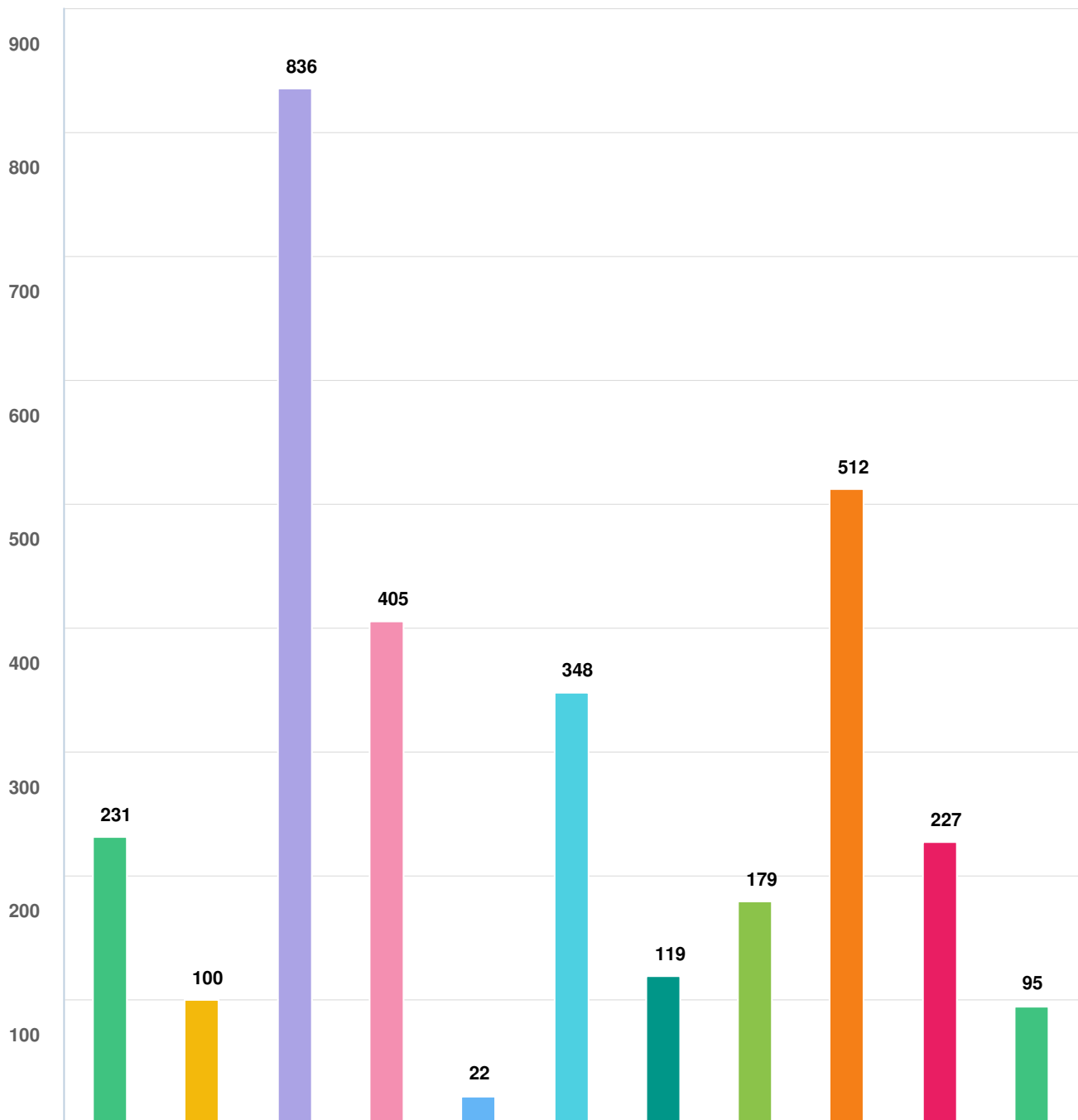
