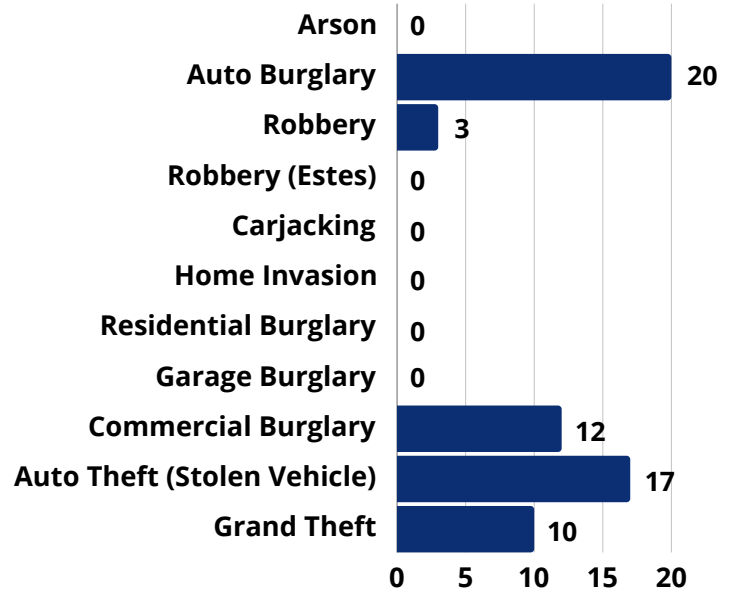

Armed Robbery

On 1/27, dispatch received a report of a robbery at a convenience store on Farwell Dr. The subject brandished a firearm at the clerk and took cash from the registers. The subject also took cigarettes, alcohol, and the clerk's wallet and phone. This case remains under investigation. #240127022

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 1/25, officers responded to a hospital emergency room on Civic Center Dr. A victim had a severe laceration in his back and told officers he had been stabbed. The victim had been brought to the hospital by his wife, and both were uncooperative with officers. Officers canvassed multiple locations but could not find evidence of a crime scene. A neighboring police department assisted with a welfare check at the victim's residence and discovered an open door with blood in the entryway. This case remains under investigation. #240125002

Battery

On 1/25, a victim was walking along Bell St when a subject began yelling at her and beating her. The victim did not know the subject. After officers arrived, the victim identified the subject and was transported for medical treatment. The subject was uncooperative upon arrest and was restrained after he assaulted jail staff. #240125031

Burglary (Residential)

On 1/23, officers investigated a rash of residential burglaries that had occurred within the last month, with a cumulative loss of around \$1 million. That evening, several units began surveilling known subjects, who traveled to a nearby city and committed burglary. Officers attempted to contain the subjects, who initially fled but were eventually arrested. Two firearms were recovered from the subjects. #240106038

Robbery

On 1/23, officers responded to a robbery at a department store on Albrae St. Three subjects confronted an employee in the electronics section. One brandished a handgun and demanded keys. The other two stole cash register drawers, which were empty. All three subjects fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240123030

Robbery

On 1/23, officers responded to a robbery at a park on Deep Creek Rd. The victim was walking down the sidewalk behind her husband and child when a subject slapped her multiple times and took her necklace. The subject fled on foot to a nearby apartment complex and was not located. This case remains under investigation. #240123017

Sideshow

On 1/28, several parties reported a large car gathering in a business center parking lot on Boscell Rd. Officers found approximately 200 people in the lot, and the group began to engage in sideshow activity. Officers conducted high visibility patrols for several hours to curb any sideshows. #P24011143

Suspicious Circumstance

On 1/27, officers responded to a report of a subject with a gun outside a bar on Fremont Blvd. The subject was drunk, and security had escorted him outside. He returned, threatening to shoot those inside. When officers arrived, the subject had fled the scene, and officers could not locate the bar patron who had seen the firearm. #240127024

Unlawful Entry

On 1/29, officers responded to a residence on Sundale Dr regarding a victim who was screaming that an unknown subject had entered her house. When officers arrived, the victim was on her patio holding her baby and a large knife. Officers found the subject heavily intoxicated and quickly detained him. He had mistakenly entered the wrong house through an unlocked door. The subject was found with several bags of illicit drugs and was arrested. #240129001

Warrant Service

On 1/24, officers responded to a gas station on Fremont Blvd regarding a subject who was preventing his mother from exiting their vehicle. Officers arrived to find the subject holding onto his mother inside of their vehicle. The subject was under the influence of illicit drugs and had several outstanding warrants. While negotiating with officers, the subject exited and reentered the vehicle several times. He eventually sat on top of the vehicle, and officers arrested him. #240124032
