




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 3/18, a victim was walking near Industrial Dr and Ingot St when three subjects exited a vehicle and battered him. The victim was struck on the head with a flashlight. The victim said he did not know any of the subjects. He was transported for medical treatment. This case remains under investigation. #240318006

## Commercial Burglary

On 3/16, officers responded to a burglary report at a storage facility on Mowry Ave. Unknown subjects breached a hole through the exterior wall into a storage unit. Once inside, they burrowed through multiple units and stole items. The facility reported multiple burglaries in one day. This case remains under investigation. #240316012

## Elder Abuse

On 3/16, a nearby police department received a report of a battery on the 35000 block of Mission Blvd. A subject had battered two elderly victims on two separate occasions, including one incident that had occurred in Fremont. FPD was asked to investigate the incident and discovered that the victim was walking past the subject's tent when the subject emerged and yelled at her. The subject spit on the victim, hit her and threw her to the ground. The other police department arrested the subject. #240316013

## Endangering a Child

On 3/17, Child Protective Services reported that a newborn had tested positive for methamphetamine at a hospital on Mowry Ave. The child had been born the day before, and the mother was a regular methamphetamine user. CPS obtained a warrant to seize the child, and an officer delivered the seizure warrant to the mother. #240317027

## Hit and Run

On 3/14, a juvenile was crossing the street on a bicycle at Leslie St and Stevenson Blvd when he was struck by a subject vehicle. The juvenile suffered minor injuries, but the vehicle fled the scene without checking on the juvenile. A witness provided a description of the vehicle, and officers located it near Mission Blvd and Niles Canyon Rd. They initiated a traffic stop and arrested the driver. #240314006

## Mental Health Evaluation

On 3/17, officers responded to a subject who reported he had been kidnapped and was being held hostage in the back of a construction machine dealership on Osgood Rd. He claimed children were being abused in the same lot. Upon arrival, officers discovered that the claims were unfounded. The subject was transported for a medical evaluation. #P24032843

## Unlawful Fire

On 3/13, officers responded to a request for assistance from the Fremont Fire Department behind a dental office on Mowry Ave. A reporting party heard a loud explosion in the area, and upon responding, FFD located and extinguished a dumpster fire. Investigation revealed that a subject had unlawfully caused the fire, and officers arrested him. #240313002

## Violation of Protective Order

On 3/17, officers responded to a subject who was carrying a long pole and talking to himself near Lassen St. Officers discovered the subject was restrained from a protected party in the area and arrested him. While at the jail, the subject became aggravated and wanted to fight officers. #240317018

## Warrant Service

On 3/16, officers responded to a residence on Oranewood Dr regarding a juvenile who said someone was trying to hit another person with a sledgehammer. Upon arriving, officers discovered that the incident was merely a verbal dispute between two residents regarding the cleaning of the residence. There was no sledgehammer involved. During their investigation, officers discovered an outstanding warrant for one of the residents and arrested him. #240316018

## Suspicious Circumstance

On 3/16, officers responded to a liquor store on Fremont Blvd regarding a report of a stabbing in front of the store. Upon arrival, officers located the subject on the ground, bleeding from his face, with a knife nearby. The subject said he had fallen. No victims were located, and the stabbing was unfounded. #240316016
