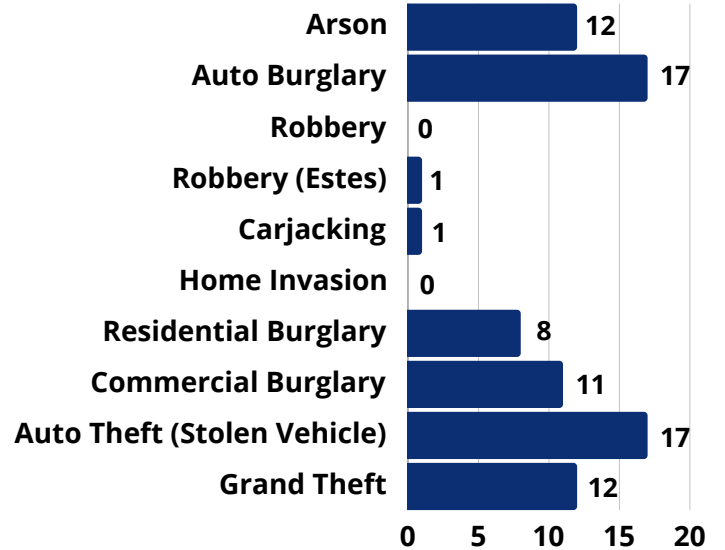




Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/3, two juveniles were in a department store parking lot on Fremont Blvd when a subject hit one of them with a wooden bat. The juveniles did not know the subject or why he had attacked them. While speaking with responding officers, the subject continued to make nonsensical statements. He was placed on a mental health hold. #240403022

Auto Theft

On 4/4, officers responded to a car dealership on Cushing Pkwy regarding a subject who drove a vehicle through the glass windows and out of the showroom. As officers arrived, two other vehicles from the dealership sped away. Officers recovered one vehicle in a nearby city and located the other driving in a different nearby city. The driver parked at an apartment complex and fled on foot but was apprehended by officers. The driver discarded a loaded firearm before being taken into custody, and a search of his apartment revealed more firearms and vehicle keys from the same dealership. #240404003

Carjacking

On 4/2, officers responded to an apartment complex on Stevenson Blvd regarding a carjacking. Three subjects pushed the victim down and drove away in her vehicle. The vehicle was located by nearby law enforcement agencies, and two subjects were seen fleeing the vehicle on foot. They were captured running through backyards in the area. The two subjects, who were found to be juveniles, were arrested. #240402034

Grand Theft

On 4/6, officers responded to a grand theft at an antique store on Niles Blvd. One subject entered the store and asked the victim to show her some jewelry from the display case. After the victim unlocked the case, another subject asked for assistance. While the victim was helping the other subject, the first subject stole antique jewelry from the display. This case remains under investigation. #240406016

Major Injury Collision

On 4/8, officers responded to a major injury collision near Fremont Blvd and Irvington Dr. A pedestrian crawled into the vehicle lane in front of a truck and was run over. He was transported to a trauma center with major injuries. #240408035

Prowling

On 4/2, a resident on Cindy St reported a subject trespassing in her backyard. Officers discovered the subject had been peeping into windows and was looking for vacant houses. He was also in possession of methamphetamine and was arrested. #240402008

Stolen Firearms

On 4/3, two subjects reported that six firearms were stolen from an out-of-service ambulance owned by one of the subjects. Several hours later, one of the subjects called to report that he and the other subject were hiding in the bushes, armed and preparing to ambush whoever had burglarized his ambulance. Officers contacted the two subjects and obtained gun violence restraining orders for both subjects. #240403026

Under the Influence - Drugs

On 4/7, officers encountered a subject who was waiting outside the gate of the police department. He said he was at the police department to report several murders but could not elaborate on who had been murdered or why. The subject told officers that he was very high and needed to stop smoking methamphetamine. He asked officers to seize the remainder of the methamphetamine, but officers did not find any. When questioned, the subject said he must have smoked it all. Officers arrested the subject. #240407003

Violation of a Protective Order

On 4/3, an abatement services employee was attempting an abatement on an encampment near Lassen St and Alameda Dr. A subject at the encampment was combative and threatened the employee. Officers also discovered that the subject was restrained from a residence nearby and arrested him. #240403008
