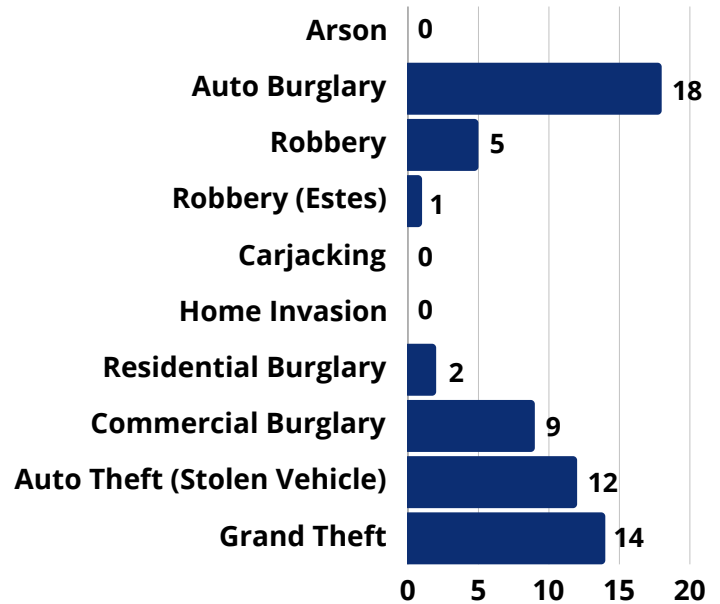

## Battery

On 4/25, officers responded to a fight at a bank on the 2700 block of Mowry Ave. A technician (victim) was fixing a damaged ATM when a subject began to shove paper into the deposit slot. When the victim asked the subject to stop, the subject punched and beat him. The subject fled, but officers located him running into the BART station, where he was arrested. #240425014

## Commercial Burglary

On 4/24, two subjects were seen prying wooden panels off an abandoned commercial building on Osgood Road. Officers set up containment and took one subject into custody. The other subject may not have entered the building. #240424027

## Domestic Violence

On 4/26, officers responded to an apartment on Central Ave regarding a victim who said her stepfather (subject) had a knife and was trying to kill her. The subject threatened the victim with a knife and strangled her until she lost consciousness. Officers responded and arrested the subject. #240426029

On 4/27, officers responded to a report that a subject near a pizza shop on Niles Blvd was battering a victim. While officers were en route, a bystander used pepper spray to end the fight, and the subject fled. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. #240427001

On 4/23, officers responded to a report of a bloodied subject holding a hammer and chasing a victim through the lobby of a hotel on Warm Springs Blvd. Officers detained both subjects. Investigation revealed that an argument between the two had escalated. The male subject inflicted minor visible injuries to the female subject, and the female subject beat the male subject with a hammer. Officers arrested both subjects. #240423031

## DUI/Hit and Run

On 4/26, a drunk driver collided with two vehicles near Auto Mall Pkwy and Grimmer Blvd. The driver fled on foot but returned to his vehicle and drove away as officers arrived. Officers conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver. #240426004

## Endangering a Child

On 4/26, officers responded to a report of a subject attempting to sell her baby near Starboard Dr and Northport Loop. The subject was pushing a stroller down the street and was seen hitting the child. The subject entered a trailer and refused to comply with officers' commands to exit. After forcing entry, officers found the child uninjured inside. Investigation revealed the child was not being cared for properly, and living conditions in the trailer were unhealthy. The subject was also restrained from the child by a criminal protective order. The child was taken into protective custody, and the subject was arrested. #240426027

## Robbery

On 2/24, a subject stole groceries from a supermarket on the 5000 block of Mowry Ave. The subject brandished a knife at an employee who had attempted to stop him. The subject fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240424028

On 4/25, officers responded to a hardware store on Mowry Ave regarding a robbery in progress. The subject stole merchandise and brandished a taser at one of the employees. The subject fled out of the back of the building. This case remains under investigation. #240425023

On 4/28, a victim and subject were meeting for a custody exchange. The subject became upset, grabbed the victim's vehicle and house keys, and threatened to kill her. The subject drove away in the victim's vehicle but returned shortly afterward. The victim eventually recovered her vehicle key, but the subject kept the house key. Officers helped clear the victim's residence and obtained temporary housing for the victim and her children. #240428022

## Unattended Death

On 4/24, a maintenance worker at an apartment on Stevenson Common reported that he had found two unresponsive subjects inside a vacant apartment. The subjects were carpet installers working on the unit to prepare it for tenants. Officers responded and discovered two subjects deceased in the apartment. There was a small bag of suspected narcotics and drug paraphernalia near the subjects. #240424007
