

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 5/18, officers responded to a bar on Peralta Blvd regarding a fight between eight to 10 subjects. The bar's security guard said the subjects attempted to force their way past him and into the bar. He said they punched and kicked him in the head multiple times. The subjects fled before officers arrived, and the security guard was transported for medical treatment. This case remains under investigation. #240518004

Battery

On 5/18, officers responded to a hospital on Mowry Ave regarding a subject who was yelling at staff and throwing equipment as he was being discharged. The subject was brought in by paramedics but had refused additional medical care. He threw a cell phone at a staff member of the hospital. The subject fled before officers arrived but was located and arrested nearby. #240518044

Brandishing a Firearm

On 5/16, a victim was involved in a road rage incident near Mission Blvd and Warm Springs Blvd. While the victim was riding a motorcycle, four to five subjects in a sedan pointed a firearm at him. This case remains under investigation. #240516001

Domestic Violence/Mental Health Hold

On 5/19, a reporting party at an apartment complex on Quantum Dr called dispatch to report that her neighbor (victim) was arguing with her boyfriend (subject). The victim sustained injuries, and items were being thrown. Officers discovered that the subject had outstanding warrants and was under a protective order that restrained him from the victim. Officers arrested the subject and walked him to the patrol vehicle. While inside the vehicle, the subject kicked out a window and made comments that warranted a mental health hold. #240519019 and #240519020

Fraud

On 5/19, officers followed up on an investigation of counterfeit \$100 bills found at markets in the Warm Springs District. An officer located a vehicle associated with the forgery and encountered two subjects who both had outstanding warrants. The two had multiple counterfeit \$100 bills on them and in their clothing. Two more subjects were found in possession of counterfeit money. Officers arrested the four subjects. #240519022

Outside Assist/Mental Health Hold

On 5/15, officers encountered a driver (subject) stopped on Mission Blvd near I-680. The subject was suffering from a medical episode, and was unresponsive despite being conscious and breathing. The driver refused to roll her windows down to engage with officers. Officers eventually breached the rear windows to render aid to the subject. The subject was transported for medical evaluation. #240515029

Trespassing

On 5/16, residents at a home on the 33000 block of Falcon Dr reported seeing an unknown subject in their backyard, looking into the windows. The residents evacuated and met with officers down the street. The subject was eventually located masturbating in a chair in the side yard. As officers approached, the subject began to smoke what appeared to be a glass meth pipe. He complied with commands to exit the backyard, and officers arrested him. #240516022

Vandalism

On 5/16, employees at a café on Mowry Ave reported that a subject had thrown a chair through the window before the store had opened. The subject entered the store as employees ran out of the rear doors. Officers arrested the subject. #240516003

On 5/20, officials at an elementary school on San Pedro Dr discovered 14 windows had been shattered at various classrooms throughout the school. This case remains under investigation. #240520014

On 5/20, officers responded to a robbery in progress at a gas station on the 46000 block of Fremont Blvd. The subject threw a rock to shatter the glass front door of the business. Two employees blocked him as he attempted to force his way into the store. Officers arrived as the subject was walking away from the business. He resisted initially, but officers eventually arrested him. #240520004
