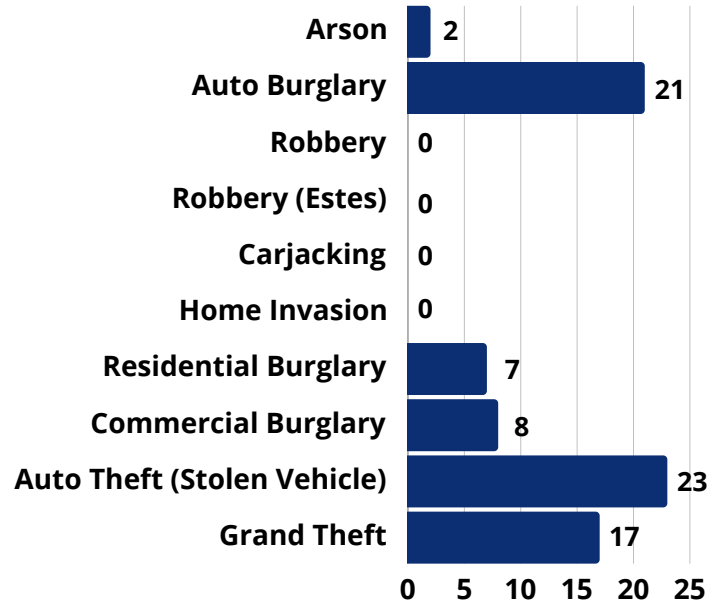

Arson

On 6/26, officers responded to a case of arson on Clough Ave. The victim found part of his canopy on fire in his driveway and saw via surveillance footage that a subject had set the fire intentionally. This case remains under investigation. #240626059

On 6/30, officers responded to a possible arson on Milton Ter. The victim found her vehicle in the parking lot with flames coming from underneath the vehicle. There was a burnt ball of toilet paper on the ground near the vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240630021

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 6/29, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at a residence on Truman Pl. A father (victim) and son (subject) were involved in an argument, during which the subject dumped water on the victim and used a metal stool to strike the victim. Officers arrested the subject. #240629018

On 6/30, officers responded to Horner Way regarding a reporting party who said her daughter (subject) was endangering those around her. The reporting party said the subject punched her several times and may have cut another family member. Juveniles in the home were sheltered in place inside their rooms. Officers arrived and arrested the subject without incident. None of the family members sustained life-threatening injuries. #240630019

Mental Health Hold

On 6/30, officers responded to a single-vehicle collision near Mowry Ave and Civic Center Dr. A vehicle had crashed into a tree, starting a fire. Before officers arrived, bystanders removed the lone occupant (subject) from the vehicle and moved him to safety. Fremont Fire Department responded to extinguish the fire and provided medical treatment to the subject. The subject said he had crashed into the tree intentionally in an attempt to kill himself. He was transported to a hospital for treatment and placed on a mental health hold. #240630004

Misc Public Service

On 6/28, the owner of a vacant house reported that a group of unknown subjects were walking in and out of the residence on Alder Ct. The owner said he had moved out of the house two weeks earlier, and the subjects were squatters. Officers arrived and called the subjects out of the residence. Three subjects exited the house, and one more person was located inside during the search. One of the subjects said he had been renting the residence for approximately three months. Officers discovered the property owner had lied about the information he had previously told officers. The dispute was determined to be a civil issue between the property owner and the subjects. #240628001

Outside Assist

On 6/25, officers assisted Fremont Fire Department and Alameda County Fire Department with a moderate/large brush fire near Stevenson Blvd. Initial indicators suggest the fire began in a nearby city and was likely sparked by faulty energy equipment. The fire spread and threatened several businesses in the area before being controlled. Officers assisted with drone footage, traffic control, and notifications to neighboring businesses. #240625025

Vandalism

On 7/1, officers responded to a convenience store on Grimmer Blvd regarding a subject who threw a large rock at a parked vehicle. Upon arrival, officers detained and arrested the subject. #240701027
