

Auto Burglary

On 7/9, a reporting party saw a subject use a rock to smash the window of a vehicle in the parking lot of an apartment complex on the 39900 block of Fremont Blvd. The subject stole property from the vehicle and fled. He was located nearby and arrested. #240709015

Battery

On 7/5, multiple parties reported a large fight near Bowie Common and Garnet Common. About 15 subjects were fighting, and one mentioned having a firearm. Officers arrived and contacted an injured party (victim), leaving the scene. Officers located a discarded stolen firearm nearby. The next day, the victim and several family members returned to Bowie Common and began arguing with the victim's ex-girlfriend and her family members. The argument turned into a physical brawl, in which one involved party brandished a golf club at another. No significant injuries were sustained. This case remains under investigation. #240705001 and #240705027

On 7/9, officers responded to the Family Resource Center on Liberty St after a subject head-butted a person receiving services. The attack was unprovoked. The subject possessed drug paraphernalia. Officers arrested the subject. #240709017

Commercial Burglary

On 7/9, the owner of a salon on the 37200 block of Fremont Blvd found a subject naked inside the business. The subject had taken items and destroyed property. The subject fled as the owner called police. Officers located the subject in the area and took him into custody without incident. #240709010

Explosion

On 7/5, officers responded to a report of an explosion at a manufacturing facility on the 44000 block of South Grimmer Blvd. Officers observed an employee with burns to his back and were informed of a possible gas leak. Outside Assist

On 7/2, officers responded to a vehicle that was fully engulfed in flames near Mission Blvd and King Ave. Fremont Fire Department responded to extinguish the fire, and officers towed it to the police department for identification. No victims were found inside or near the vehicle. The vehicle was later discovered to be a stolen vehicle. #240702001

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 7/2, officers responded to a report that a subject threw a tire iron at passing vehicles near Thornton Ave and Blacow Rd. The subject was also seen walking through traffic. Officers located the subject and found him showing signs of stimulant abuse. He was also in possession of a meth pipe. Officers arrested the subject. #240702037

Residential Burglary

On 7/2, officers responded to a report of an in-progress burglary at a residence on Shenandoah Pl. A subject forcefully entered the residence and was sleeping in the attached garage. The residence was vacant and under construction. Officers called the subject to exit the residence, and the subject eventually surrendered and was arrested. #240702014

Suspicious Circumstances

On 7/6, officers responded to a report of an armed robbery at a bank on Paseo Padre Pkwy. The reporting party said he had been robbed at gunpoint by two subjects near the ATM, who took cash and the reporting party's watch. Officers located video surveillance in the area, which showed the reporting party going to the ATM and returning safely to his vehicle. No robbery was seen. #240706027

Vandalism

On 7/6, an employee at a church on Maple St saw a subject throw a rock through a window at the church. This case remains under investigation. #240706007
