## **Neighborhood Crime Watch (NCW)**

Neighborhood Crime Watch (NCW) is a partnership between residents and law enforcement to improve safety and prevent crime. NCW block captains organize neighbors to look out for one another and report crime in the neighborhood.

## **Volunteers In Police Services (VIPS)**

Our volunteers are a valuable part of the Police Department. Volunteers perform neighborhood patrol checks, engage with the community at events, and provide other support functions.

# Explorer Program (teens 14 - 18)

# Surveillance Camera Registration Program

# Trespassing Agreements and Court Orders

#### **Alarm Permits**
