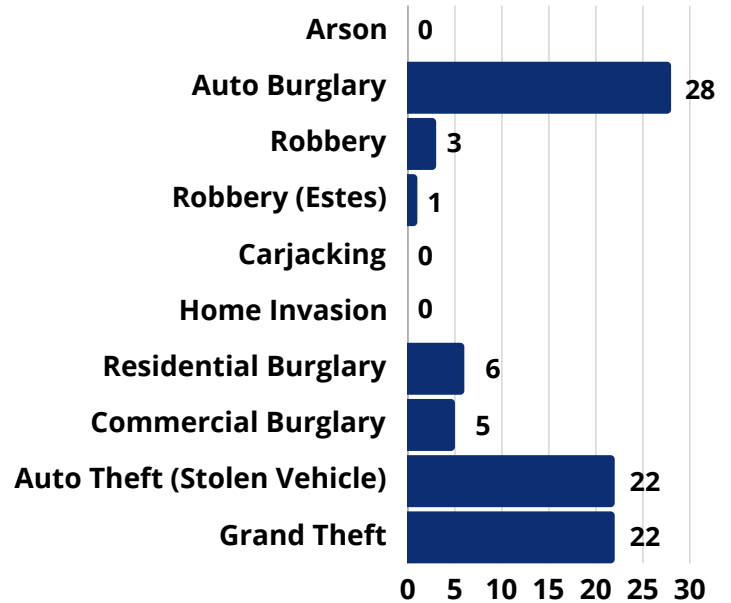

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 7/10, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at an encampment near Washington Blvd and Osgood Rd. A subject confronted the victim about stealing a meth pipe, and the two were involved in a physical altercation. The subject struck the victim several times with a crowbar. The victim had significant injuries from the attack. Officers eventually located the subject and arrested him. #240710003

On 7/12, officers responded to a report that a subject had broken into a residence on Bryant Common and was fighting with her mother's boyfriend. Officers arrived to find both the subject and the mother's boyfriend holding knives inside the entryway to the residence. Both eventually surrendered. The subject, who had broken into the apartment, was discovered to be the mother's ex-boyfriend. He was arrested. #240712002

## Residential Burglary

On 7/12, two victims at a residence on Telles Ln awoke to find a shirtless subject asleep in their bedroom chair. The victims left the residence and called police. Officers responded and arrested the subject.

## Vandalism

On 7/15, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a convenience store on Fremont Blvd. A subject had thrown a glass bottle and shattered a glass door and window. Officers responded and detained the subject. The convenience store employee did not desire prosecution, so the subject was released. Shortly afterward, the subject took a pot from a grocery store on Fremont Blvd and threw it at the store's window. The subject was arrested. #240715002 and #240715003

## Vehicle Collision

On 7/15, officers responded to a report of a vehicle driving into a building on the 39600 block of Mission Blvd. The vehicle had driven into the building's north side of a business. No employees were working on that side of the building, and no injured community members were discovered. The driver remained on scene and was uninjured. Fremont Fire Department responded to assess the damage to the building and assist in removing the vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240715030
