#### Arson

On 7/23, officers responded to a report of a subject who lit a fire near Thornton Ave and the I-880 on-ramp. Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire. Officers found a subject nearby who matched the description provided by witnesses. The subject admitted to consuming intoxicating drugs before officers arrived. He was arrested. #240723026

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 7/25, officers responded to several calls regarding a subject who was throwing objects inside a drugstore on Fremont Blvd. The subject was running through the store with a large stick and breaking windows. He threw a glass light tube at an employee and brandished a metal chair at two other employees. Despite the store being evacuated, the subject refused to leave and threw glass jars at officers. When officers attempted to negotiate with the subject, he climbed on a shelf and began striking it. Officers found that the subject possessed what appeared to be methamphetamine and arrested him. #240725030

On 7/25, officers responded to a battery in progress near Sundale Dr and Liberty St. The victim was lying on the sidewalk, injured. The subject exited his residence nearby, and both parties were taken to a hospital. The victim and subject had been fighting over purchasing a vehicle, and the subject believed the vehicle had been stolen. The subject used a metal object to strike the victim in the head. Officers arrested the subject. #240725023

## **Domestic Violence**

On 7/24, officers responded to an apartment on Beacon Ave regarding a domestic violence incident. The subject threw eggs at the victim's vehicle, battered her, and threatened to kill her. The victim fled to the Fremont Police Department, where officers arrested the subject. #240724056

## Mental Health Hold

On the evening of 7/23, officers responded to a report of a disturbance on Blacow Rd and Stevenson Blvd. A subject was digging a hole and throwing dirt on herself. Officers attempted to contact her, but she walked away, running into the roadway amid oncoming traffic. Officers contacted the subject on the campus of a nearby high school and placed her on a mental health hold. #240723014

#### Robbery

On 7/28, a juvenile victim reported a robbery near a store at the Fremont Hub. The subject grabbed the victim's bicycle and attempted to ride away on it. The victim grabbed the handlebars, but the subject shoved him to the ground and fled. Officers located the bicycle at a halfway house in another city. Employees at the halfway house made the subject return the bicycle to the victim's mother. A warrant was issued for the subject. #240728014

#### **Shots Fired**

On 7/27, officers responded to a possible shooting at a bar on Mowry Ave. There was a large group in the parking lot, and the reporting party heard four shots fired. Investigation revealed that a fight had started between multiple subjects, and one subject shot multiple rounds into the pavement. The subject fled before officers arrived, but officers located three shell casings and one live round in the parking lot. No victims related to this incident were found. Officers later located the subject's vehicle and conducted a stop. The driver was found in possession of ammunition and brass knuckles and was later positively identified as the subject in the initial incident. This case remains under investigation. #240727004

#### Vandalism

On 7/24, officers responded to a report of vandalism near High St and Union St. A subject used two bats to smash out multiple car windows. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. #240724034

On 7/29, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a residence on Heritage Common. The victim's vehicle was keyed with several slurs. This case remains under investigation. #240729007
