

Arson

On 9/1, an officer responded to an arson attempt in the parking lot of a bar on Mowry Ave. The reporting party extinguished a rag on fire next to a vehicle. Officers discovered that the vehicle had been doused in gasoline, and it appeared someone had attempted to set the vehicle on fire. The reporting party was involved in a bar fight earlier that evening and thought that one of the subjects involved in the flight had attempted to destroy his vehicle. #240901008

On 9/1, officers responded to a possible arson at a commercial building on Brown Rd. An employee noticed a fire on the exterior of the building but extinguished it before it caused extensive damage. The fire appeared to have been set intentionally. #240901010

On 9/1, officers provided support as the Fremont Fire Department responded to two fires on the railroad tracks near Paseo Padre Pkwy and Tupelo St. While responding, officers located an additional fire in another location on the train tracks. #240901034

On 9/2, officers responded to a dumpster fire in a parking lot near Fremont Blvd and Alder Ave. The same evening, another fire was located near a restaurant on Fremont Blvd, against the restaurant's exterior wall. The fire appeared to have been accelerated by a bundle of newspapers. An hour later, officers responded to another fire in a trash can outside the DMV on Central Ave, and another fire in a field near a liquor store on Peralta Blvd. The two fires were also started using a stack of newspapers. Another fire was located that evening in a trash can on Sundale Dr. These cases remain under investigation. #240902004, #240902005, #240902007, and #240902009

Found Child

On 8/28, officers responded to the Mowry Ave and State St area after several parties reported a juvenile who appeared lost and in need of assistance. Officers contacted the juvenile, who was unable to communicate any identifying information. Officers searched the area for responsible family members but could not find anyone. Officers transported the juvenile to the Fremont Police Department. Later that evening, the juvenile's mother called to report her daughter missing, and officers reunited the juvenile with her family. #240828020

Indecent Exposure

On 9/2, officers responded to multiple reports of a subject exposing himself and engaging in lewd activity outside a drugstore on Fremont Blvd. One victim said the subject was looking at her juvenile son and masturbating in front of her vehicle before she drove away. The subject resisted officers but was eventually arrested. #240902035

Residential Burglary

On 9/1, officers responded to a report of a burglary at a residence on Foxtail Ter. The two victims were in their bedroom when they saw a subject slide the window open. Both victims yelled at the subject, and the subject fled the area. This case remains under investigation. #240901005

Vandalism

On 9/3, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a clothing store at the Fremont Hub. Two subjects drove by, and one shot out the store's glass door. The subject also shot out the window of a bakery in the same complex. Officers located the vehicle and detained the two subjects. Inside the vehicle, officers found a rifle-style BB gun, which was consistent with the damage caused to the store windows. Officers arrested one subject. #240903002

Warrant Service

On 8/31, officers responded to a report of arson outside a party supply store on Fremont Blvd. A subject was setting a tree on fire. Officers discovered the subject had an active warrant and arrested him. #240806017
