

## **Burglary**

Officers located the subject hiding in a crawl space on the fourth floor. The subject initially refused to leave but eventually surrendered. Officers arrested the subject. #240904008

### **Domestic Violence**

On 9/3, officers responded to an apartment on Quantum Dr regarding a domestic violence investigation. The subject battered the victim and threatened to return with his gun and shoot her. The subject left the apartment before officers arrived but was located in a nearby city. Officers arrested the subject and recovered a firearm associated with the subject. #240903052

On 9/5, officers responded to a business on the 44000 block of S Grimmer Blvd regarding a loud argument and assault between two subjects. Officers located one subject in the parking lot bleeding heavily from the face. The subject was uncooperative and challenged officers to fight, but officers de-escalated the situation and detained the subject. Officers contacted the other subject, who was the girlfriend of the first subject. She said the first subject had choked her and threatened to kill her, so she smashed his head with a phone. #### Misc. Public Service

On 9/5, a reporting party advised that two subjects were brandishing firearms in the parking lot of a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. Officers responded and contacted the two subjects, finding that they had a replica BB gun in their vehicle. Officers contacted the reporting party, who revised his story to state that no brandishing had occurred, and he had only seen the BB gun in their vehicle. #240905033

#### **Sideshow**

On 9/6, Dispatch received a call from a nearby police department advising of a large sideshow forming near Washington Blvd and Osgood Rd. Officers from the other department had trailed more than 300 vehicles into the city. Multiple residents also advised that pedestrians and vehicles were blocking the intersection. FPD officers responded and forced participants out of the city, dispersing the crowd. #P24106415

## **Suspicious Circumstance**

On 9/5, officers responded to the Industrial Dr and Quality Ln area regarding a possible shooting. The reporting party had a superficial wound to his face and believed he had been shot with an air pellet gun. Upon investigation, no pellets or other projectiles were located. #240905034

### **Unlawful Peeking**

On 9/6, a resident on Blair PI reported that a shirtless subject was looking through their windows in their backyard. The subject had also taken a pair of slippers from the back patio and was wearing them. Officers responded and convinced the subject to surrender, then arrested him outside the residence. #240906003

On 9/6, officers responded to a report of a subject vandalizing vehicles near Country Dr and Hastings St. The subject fled on foot, jumping fences and traveling through a nearby high school. Officers established a perimeter and apprehended the subject. The subject was arrested. #240906002
