

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 9/10, officers responded to a restaurant on Fremont Blvd regarding an altercation between multiple parties, with one subject waving a gun. Officers learned that the subject was attempting to enter the property, and the owners (victims) attempted to remove him from the property. The subject struck one victim with a gun and brandished it at him, threatening to kill him. The victim used his own firearm to discharge three rounds into the subject's leg, and the two victims disarmed the subject of his weapon. Three casings were located on the scene. Officers arrested the subject, and the two victims were transported for medical clearance. #240910012

## Brandishing a Firearm

On 9/12, two drivers were involved in a road rage altercation that began on I-680 and continued onto Mission Blvd near Las Palmas Ave. One driver (subject) brandished a handgun at the other driver (victim) and threatened to kill him. The subject also yelled slurs at the victim as he threatened him. Officers stopped the subject vehicle in another city and then arrested the subject. Officers seized a replica firearm in his vehicle. #240912026

## Criminal Threats

On 9/14, officers responded to a report of a subject causing a disturbance at an auto repair shop on Maple St. The subject threatened to burn down the business, kill one of the employees, and bring gang members to attack him. The subject also threw a shotgun round at another victim. The subject was gone before officers arrived, but they saw him leaving in a vehicle and stopped him. The subject yielded, and officers arrested him. #240914013

## Indecent Exposure

On 9/12, an employee at a salon on Grimmer Blvd reported that a subject had pulled his pants down, exposing himself to the employee and her customer. The subject entered other shops in the area, exposing himself to another business. Officers located the subject at a grocery store nearby and arrested him. #240912034

## Residential Burglary

On 9/14, officers responded to a residential burglary on Medina Common in which the victim woke up to find a subject rummaging through her belongings. The subject was wearing only a shirt and asked the victim to smoke marijuana with her. The subject eventually left the residence, but officers found her inside the victim's vehicle. ## Resisting Arrest

On 9/11, officers responded to the Nicolet Ave and Fremont Blvd area regarding two subjects fighting. One subject had two knives with him and had brandished them at the other subject. Officers saw the first subject fleeing the area on a bicycle as they arrived. He was attempting to hide behind some bushes in the front yard of a residence. ## Robbery

On 9/10, an officer responded to a hospital on Mowry Ave regarding an attempted robbery in the Paseo Padre Pkwy and Isherwood Way area. The victim rode his bike to the hospital with a stab wound and was being treated. An unknown subject had attempted to rob the victim at knifepoint. This case remains under investigation. #240910001

## Vandalism

On 9/14, an officer responded to a report of vandalism near Farwell Dr and Eggers Dr. A subject was walking down the street smashing car windows. The officer made contact and told the subject he was being detained. The subject fled on foot, but the officer quickly apprehended and arrested him. #240914003
