Battery

On 10/13, officers responded to a fight in progress at an adult baseball game at a park on Alder Ave. A coach from one team ran onto the field and punched the umpire, knocking him out. When officers arrived, the subject had fled. #241013023

Carjacking

On 10/9, officers responded to a report of an armed carjacking at an apartment complex on Fremont Blvd. The victim approached her vehicle and saw a subject in the driver's seat. When confronted, the subject opened the door and held a handgun to her, then fled in the vehicle. The vehicle was later located abandoned in the parking lot of another apartment complex. This case remains under investigation. #241009020

Commercial Burglary

On 10/11, officers responded to a yard on Boscell Rd regarding a commercial burglary. Corporate security advised they were watching a live video feed showing two subjects tampering with the gate to the property. The subjects entered the site, then jumped the fence and fled. Officers located the subjects nearby and discovered electrical components from the yard in their vehicle. Both subjects were arrested. #241011003

On 10/10, a resident reported that they were the victim of a scam in which they gave a subject \$30,000 in cash. A subject called, claiming to be from the FBI, and said they were investigating the victim for identity theft. They instructed the victim to give the cash to another subject, who came to the victim's home and took the cash. Investigation revealed that the call was not from a law enforcement agency. #241010008

Residential Burglary

On 10/12, a contractor (reporting party) reported a burglary at a residence on Faulkner Dr that he was working on. The reporting party found the rear sliding door was open and heard movement in the home's crawl space. Officers responded and set up a perimeter, hearing more noise from inside the home. Shortly afterward, one subject was seen fleeing over the back fence. He was detained several houses away. A second subject was detained at a neighboring house. Officers arrested both subjects. #241012012

Robbery

On 10/10, a victim reported that multiple subjects robbed him at knifepoint and took his dog at a convenience store on Mohave Dr. The victim had picked up an escort in another city and stopped at the convenience store. When the victim stepped out of the store, a subject held a knife to him and demanded all his money. When he refused, the subject took his dog. The escort with the victim got into the subject's vehicle and fled with the subject. This case remains under investigation. #241010003

Shots Fired

On 10/12, officers responded to a battery incident between multiple subjects, which occurred in the parking lot of a bar on Mowry Ave. As officers were responding, a reporting party advised that a firearm had been brandished at one of the subjects, and the parties involved fled before officers arrived. Two spent shell casings were located in the parking lot, and two vehicles in the parking lot were found to have been vandalized. Witnesses said the incident was an altercation between multiple customers at the bar, and two shots were fired into the air during the incident. There were no shooting victims or battery victims located on scene or at local hospitals, and no one on scene could identify the subjects. #241012001

Suspicious Circumstance

On 10/9, officers responded to a report of a potential meth lab at an apartment on Sundale Dr. The reporting party had found mason jars full of chemicals in the apartment. Officers executed a search warrant for the apartment, seizing numerous items. This case remains under investigation. #241009027
