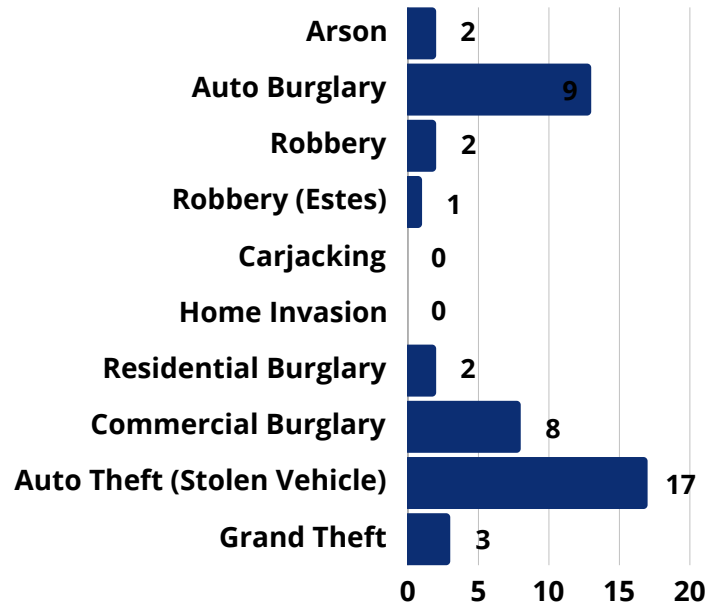




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Arson

On 10/21, an officer responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at a business on Blacow Rd. The reporting party said surveillance footage showed a subject had ripped a paper sign from the door. The subject lit the paper on fire and threw it in the mail slot of the business's front door. The reporting party said the subject also threw a rock against the window. This case remains under investigation. #241021014

On 10/21, a manager at a construction company on Business Center Dr reported a fire on her property. A cement enclosure and the construction equipment inside it had been burned. Surveillance footage showed a subject tampering with the enclosure, then leaving as the enclosure became fully engulfed in flames. A neighbor put out the fire. #241021019

## Outside Assist

On 10/21, the U.S. Foreign Service sent over 20 Special Agents to serve an arrest warrant for a fraud case. FPD officers provided a uniform presence for the arrest on the 4000 block of Central Ave, and the arrest was made without incident. #P24124748

## Prowling

On 10/20, officers responded to a residence on Mattos Dr regarding a burglary. The homeowner saw a video feed of a subject armed with a large machete inside their detached garage. Officers arrived and located a subject inside the garage. The subject was found to be a sex offender who was in violation of registration requirements. Officers arrested the subject. #241020004

## Residential Burglary

On 10/20, officers responded to a residence on Siward Dr regarding possible squatters inside the home. The reporting party said he had been out of town for the past few months, but his neighbor advised him that two subjects were staying inside his residence. ## Robbery

On 10/15, a victim reported a robbery near Blacow Rd and Coco Palm Dr, The victim was walking with her child when two subjects in a vehicle stopped near her. One subject exited the vehicle and asked for directions, then pulled the necklace from the victim's neck. The subjects fled in the vehicle. #241015032

## Shoplifting

On 10/16, officers responded to a drugstore on Mowry Ave regarding a disturbance. A store employee said a subject inside was grabbing items and throwing them on the floor. Officers arrived and arrested the subject. #241016016

## Swatting Call

On 10/15, the National Human Trafficking Hotline contacted FPD to advise they were texting a subject who claimed to be a juvenile who was being trafficked. The subject said the trafficker had a gun and was holding her at an apartment in Fremont. Officers attempted numerous phone calls and text messages with no response, then attempted to make contact at the door. The apartment appeared to be vacant from the outside. Officers determined the call was likely to be a swatting call. #241016002

## Trespassing

On 10/15, officers responded to a business on Prune Ave regarding possible squatter activity. A subject was found inside the building but said he did not force entry and was storing belongings there. He advised that other subjects had been doing the same. Officers arrested the subject. #241015028

## Vandalism

On 10/14, officers responded to a liquor store on Fremont Blvd regarding an alarm. The property owner arrived to find a subject hitting the front door with a metal pipe. Upon arrival, officers located the subject, who fled on foot but was apprehended nearby. The subject was taken to a hospital for medical clearance. #241014035
