



  - Non-Emergency 31,264




Fremont PD Police Reports Documented - 21,620 (8% increase)


### Crime in Fremont

	2018	2019
Homicide	3	1
Rape	51	36
Robbery	213	159
Aggravated Assault	222	204
Total	489	400

- Part I Crimes 5% decrease
- Violent Crimes 20% decrease
- Property Crime 3% decrease
- Thefts from Vehicle 13%
  increase




### 5-Year Crime Trend








