

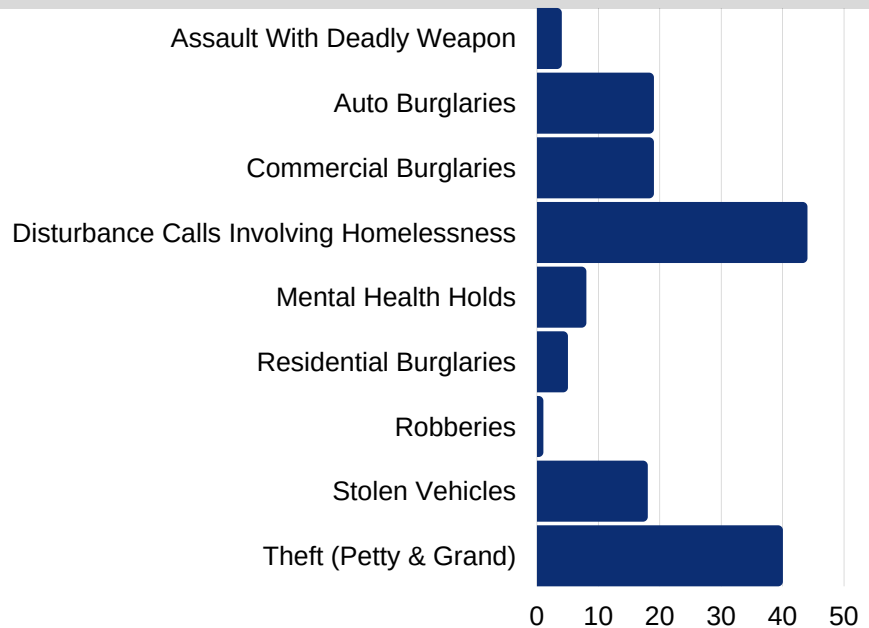


# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 8/10/20 officers responded to a report of a stabbing on the 4900 block of Stevenson Blvd. The victim walked onto his patio in the middle of the night. An unknown person was standing in the corner of the patio and slashed the victim with a knife before fleeing. #200812001
