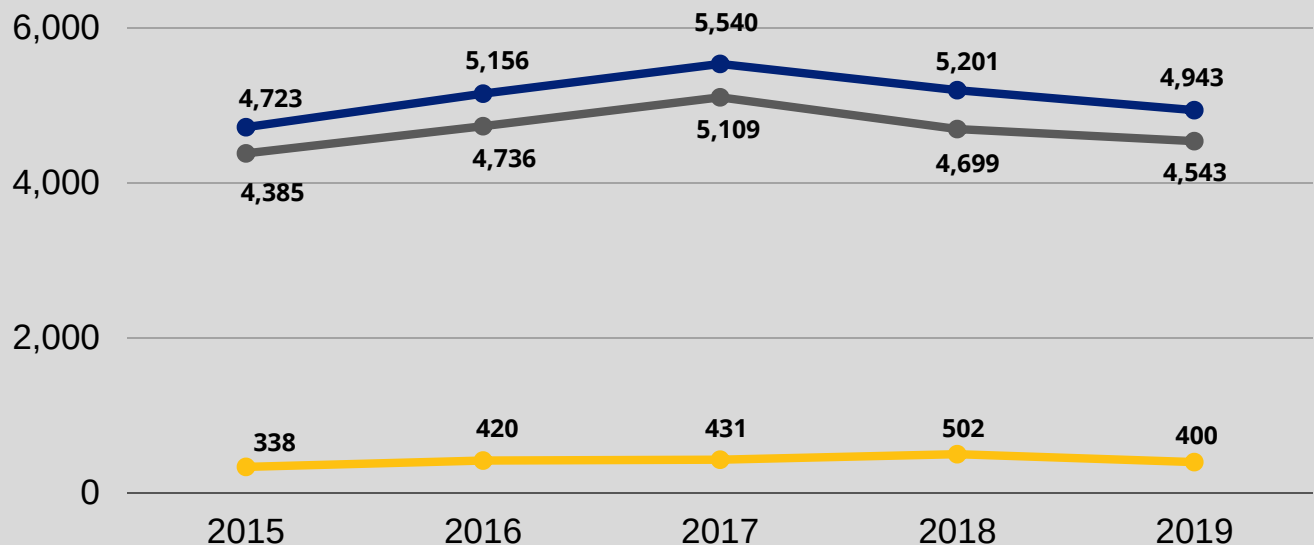

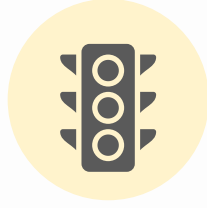
FIVE YEAR CRIME TREND 2015 - 2019



- Part I Crimes** include homicide, rape, robbery, arson, aggravated assault, theft, auto theft and burglary.
- Property Crimes** include auto theft, theft from vehicle, residential burglaries, commercial burglaries and larceny theft.
- Violent Crimes** include homicide, rape, robbery and aggravated assault.

From 2018 to 2019, we saw a
20% decrease in violent crime
and a **3% decrease in property crime.**

***PRISONERS BOOKED** at the Fremont Jail include those booked by Newark PD, Union City PD and CHP.

****OF THE 12 PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS COMPLAINTS RECEIVED:**

One (1) Exonerated: The incident occurred, but member actions were lawful and proper, and/or justified departure from policy.

One (1) Sustained Component: An allegation is supported by a preponderance of the evidence.

Three (3) Pending Cases: These complaints were reported to DOJ as pending at end of 2019 and their investigations have since concluded. The findings were two (2) unfounded and one (1) exonerated.

Seven (7) Unfounded Cases: The complainant admits to false allegation; the charges were found to be false; the member was not involved in the incident; or the complainant has voluntarily withdrawn the complaint.
