


# Fremont Police Week In Review

# **Assault With Deadly Weapon**

On 10/19/20 an assault with a deadly weapon occurred at 46840 Lakeview Blvd. Victim arrived to work and was walking inside when confronted by a man, he demanded to be driven somewhere. When the victim declined, the man pulled out a knife and began swinging it towards the victim in an attempt to stab him. The man fled the area on foot. #201019002

# **Brandishing A Weapon & Battery**

On 10/18/20 a brandishing occurred near 37235 Fremont Blvd. A victim was walking on Fremont Blvd when a female threw a cup of water onto her. As the victim attempted to take a picture of the female she began to attack the victim and pulled her hijab off while striking her with her hand. The female continued to threaten the victim with a stick. Officers contacted the victim, she had no visible injuries and requested no medical attention. Jaqualyn Moses (33) homeless out of Fremont was contacted in the area, identified, and arrested. Jaqualyn was issued a notice to appear. #20101802

#### **Estes Robbery**

When refused, the man entered the car and burned the victim with a lighter in an attempt to get him to move over. Victim exited his vehicle in fear the man had a weapon, the man fled in the vehicle. The vehicle was later located in San Jose and had been completely burned. #201019003
