


Fremont Police Week In Review

October 27, 2020 - November 2, 2020



Arson

On 10/31/20, officers responded to a community member on Nolan Terrace reporting a male throwing rocks and starting a fire near his residence. The resident put out a fire near his wooden patio while the officer put out two small vegetation fires with a fire extinguisher before the arrival of Fremont Fire personnel. Officers located and detained a man as he was walking away from the area of the fires. The man spontaneously told officers that he lit the fires with a lighter that was recovered on his person, and identified by the community member. Martin Pitts (40) homeless out of Fremont was arrested for arson and an outstanding felony grand theft warrant. #201031003

Auto Burglary

201027029 – officers responded after receiving a call from a victim reporting a man inside of her locked vehicle in the Motel 6, 34047 Fremont Blvd parking lot. A man was detained and identified by the victim, all property was recovered. Obra Rogue (38) homeless out of Hayward was arrested. #201027029

Carjacking (Attempted)

On 10/31/20, officers were dispatched to an attempted carjacking at Chevron, 37635 Blacow Rd. A vehicle pulled behind the victim's vehicle, two males exited, pointed handguns at the victim and demanded his keys. The victim walked into the store uninjured and the suspects fled the scene. #201031011

Commercial Burglary

On 10/30/20, officers responded to an in-progress commercial burglary at the Mission Boulevard Market, 46370 Mission Blvd. The people responsible fled prior to officers arrival. #201030006

Residential Burglary

On 10/27/20, a victim woke up to see a flashlight poking through a side window as he slept in his bedroom on the 3700 block of Union St. He also noticed a torso coming through the window and he yelled out immediately. The person quickly fled out to the yard and jumped over fences. Officers quickly arrived in the area to search for the person responsible. Julian Dupes (19) out of Fremont was arrested. #201027001

On 10/30/20, officers responded to a report of a garage residential burglary on Fiano Common. The victim found a man inside his garage, after the victim banged on the door the man appeared to be scared off and fled. The man accessed the garage using a garage door remote stolen from inside the victim's unlocked vehicle parked out front. #201030005

Robbery

On 10/30/20, officers responded to a report of an armed robbery at the Little Caesars, 4376 Thornton Av. A man pointed a gun at the victim and demanded money. The man fled prior to officers arrival, the victim was not injured. #201030025
