


# Fremont Police Week In Review

## **Auto Burglary**

On 12/11, a work van was burglarized on Carol Av with a substantial loss of property. #201211008

### **Commercial Burglary**

On 12/11 at approximately 1:50 am officers responded to a report of man cutting a chain link fence, at Newcomb Tree Experts, at Fremont Blvd and Auto Mall Pkwy. Officer arrived to stop the suspects while they were still in their vehicle. Jose Perez Romo (37) out of San Jose was arrested. #201211003

On 12/12 at approximately 1:00 am a person smashed the front glass door of Zorba's Deli, 46505 Mission Blvd. The person had fled prior to officers arrival; chunks of concrete was located near the door. #201212004

## **Residential Burglary**

On 12/9 at approximately 7:00 pm, two suspects attempted to break into the rear of a house on Windmill Drive. A back patio camera captured the suspects wearing gloves peering into the windows. They appeared to notice the camera and fled. 201209035

On 12/11 at approximately 7:30 pm a suspect entered a home on the 43000 block of Paseo Padre Pkwy. The suspect fled once he encountered the resident who screamed. The suspect gained access into the room through the rear sliding glass door. #201211031

#### Robbery

On 12/8 at approximately 5:25 pm, a chain snatch robbery occurred on Blackstone Way. A woman was on a walk when a man in a black face mask approached and spoke to her before grabbing the chain from her neck. #201208031

On 12/8 at approximately 8:42 pm an attempt robbery occurred in the area of Gable Dr and Mcduff Ave. The victim was walking when he was approached by a man asking for directions. The suspect demanded he hand over everything or he would be shot. The victim was able to run away. #201208036
