

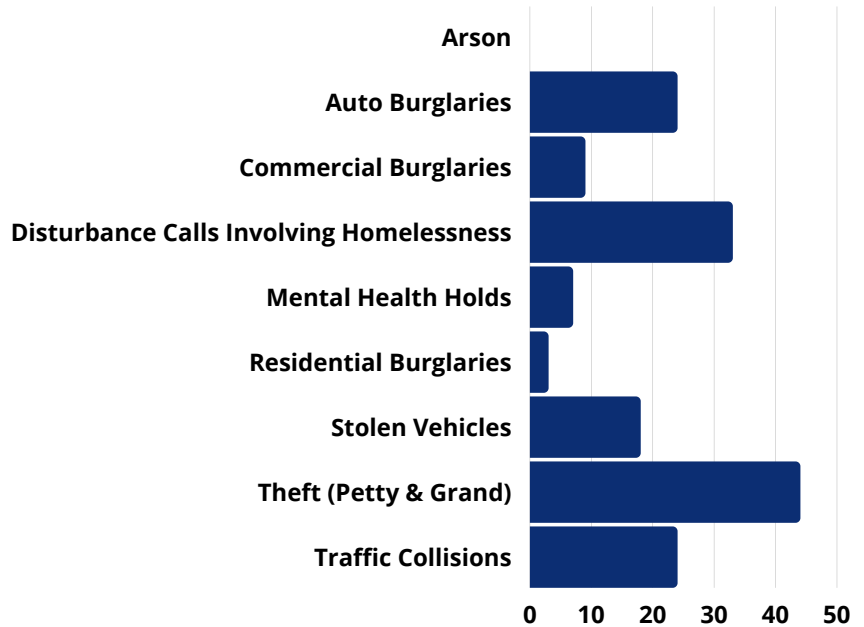


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault

On 12/22 officers responded to an assault inside an abandoned factory on Shinn St. A male victim was assaulted by an unknown man with a metal pipe. The victim was transported and provided medial attention. #201222001

Auto Burglary

On 12/24 an auto burglary occurred at 46809 Warm Springs Blvd. A witness interrupted the burglary by yelling out at the suspects. #201224018

Carjacking

On 12/23 a carjacking occurred at Beard Rd and Mello Way. The victim was making an Amazon delivery on Beard Rd when an unknown man jumped into his driver's seat and began to drive off. The victim ran towards his vehicle yelling at which time the suspect stopped the truck. The suspect appeared to reach for what the victim thought was a gun; no gun was seen. The victim stopped chasing the truck ad the suspect fled. The vehicle was later located at Union Square in Union City abandoned. #201223017

Commercial Burglary

On 12/24 a commercial burglary occurred at Little Steamers Preschool, 43531 Mission Blvd. A man entered the school overnight through the double doors which may or may not have been locked. Several electronic items were taken with an estimated loss of over \$12,000. #201224013

On 12/28 there was a attempted burglary at Little Steamers Preschool, 43531 Mission Blvd. A man was seen on video trying to open the doors, this time they were locked. No loss or damage was reported. #201228022

Residential Burglary

On 12/23 a residential burglary occurred on the 700 block of Nodaway Ave. Two suspects wearing masks smashed the rear slider and made entry. The suspects were scared away by a neighbor yelling out at them. #201223029

On 12/24 a residential burglary occurred on the 3800 block of Almond Ave. The victim was home with her children when an unknown suspect broke through the locked front door. The suspect fled after hearing the victim. #201224024

Robbery

On 12/23 a robbery occurred at 46228 Warm Springs Blvd. A victim was sitting inside her vehicle when a suspect approached her car and attempted to open her passenger door. The door was locked; the suspect proceeded to break the window and steal the victims purse. #201223028

On 12/24 an Estes robbery occurred at 7-11, 46650 Mohave Dr. A male suspect entered the store and eventually walked behind the counter; pushing the clerk out of the way and trying to punch him. The male stole multiple lottery tickets and cigarettes and fled the store on foot. #201224003

On 12/26 an Estes robbery occurred at CVS, 4020 Fremont Hub. Three suspects entered the store and began to steal items. When confronted by an employee one of the suspects punched the employee in the face. #201226031
