

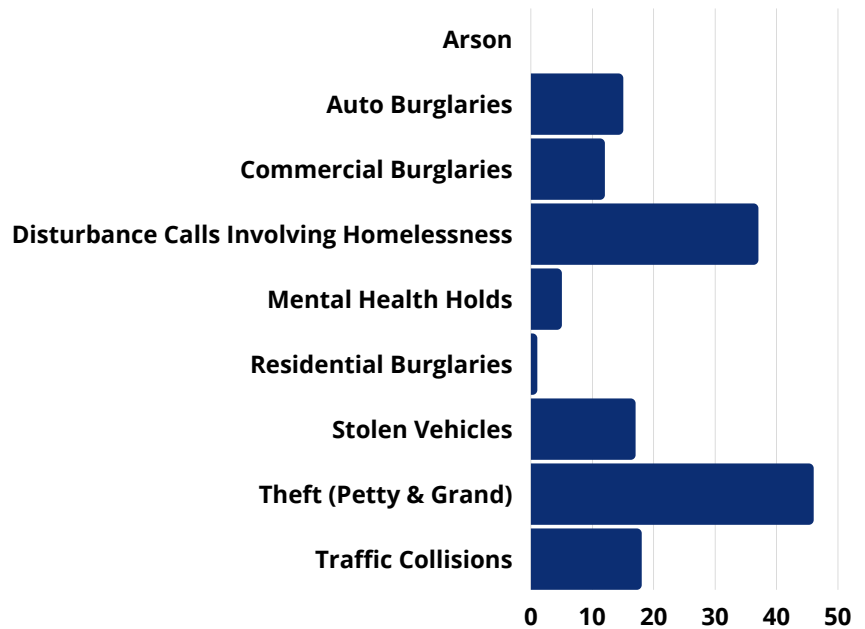


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Theft

On 12/29 a stolen Porsche Cayenne was located parked at 39201 Fremont Blvd. Anna Ramakrishnan (53) out of Santa Clara was found sitting inside and arrested. #201229023

Carjacking

On 12/29 a carjacking, shoplifting, vandalism and battery occurred at GNC, 39308 Argonaut Way. A man entered GNC without a mask and was asked to leave, which he did but not before stealing a hat. The man returned and assaulted an employee by punching him in the side and back. The man then vandalized the employee's car before leaving the area. A short time later the man attempted to carjack a vehicle at the Valero gas station. Matthew Aquino (31) homeless out of Fremont was identified, located and taken into custody. #201229035

On 01/02 a commercial burglary occurred at OO Liquors, 34460 Fremont Blvd. Large rocks were thrown through a window to gain access. #210102008

Residential Burglary

On 12/29 an attempted residential burglary occurred on the 1000 block of Mowry Ave. An unknown suspect attempted to open the rear door of the residence. #201229013

Robbery

On 12/29 a robbery occurred at Whole Foods, 3111 Mowry Ave. A man was inside the store attempting to steal alcohol when confronted by security. The man attempted to flee and resisted; security detained the man until officers arrived. Stephen Finney (40) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #201229034

On 01/03 a man walked up to three victims and told them to empty their pockets on Howard Common. When they did not, the man brandished a knife. The victims were able to run away; the suspect was identified and contacted in the area. Darshon Algere (43) out of Fremont was arrested for attempted robbery, brandishing, and criminal threats. #210103021

Vandalism

On 12/29 a male suspect was seen trying to open a vehicle door at 38660 Lexington St. When that didn't work the suspect broke three vehicle windows. Anthony Pablo (22) homeless out of Fremont was identified and arrested. #201229038
