

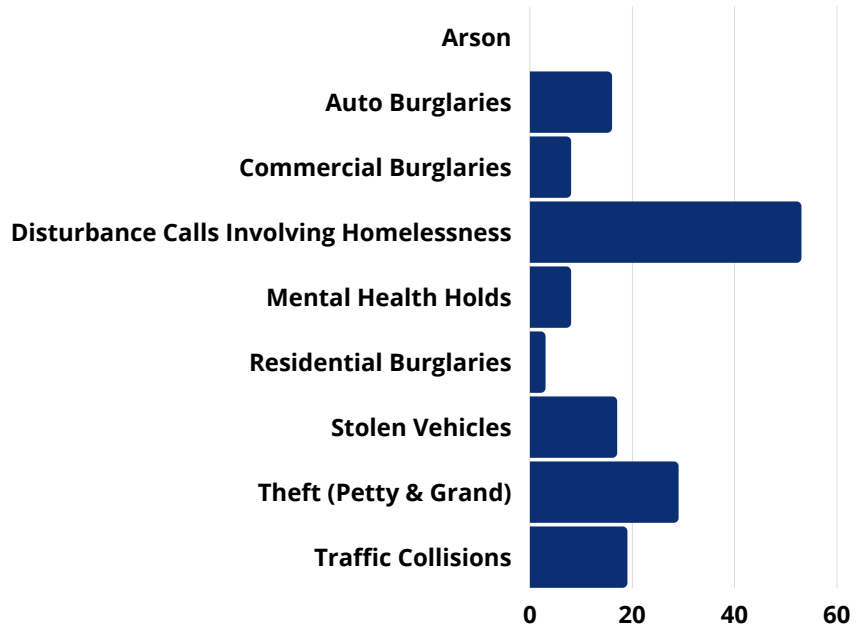


# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Auto Burglary
