

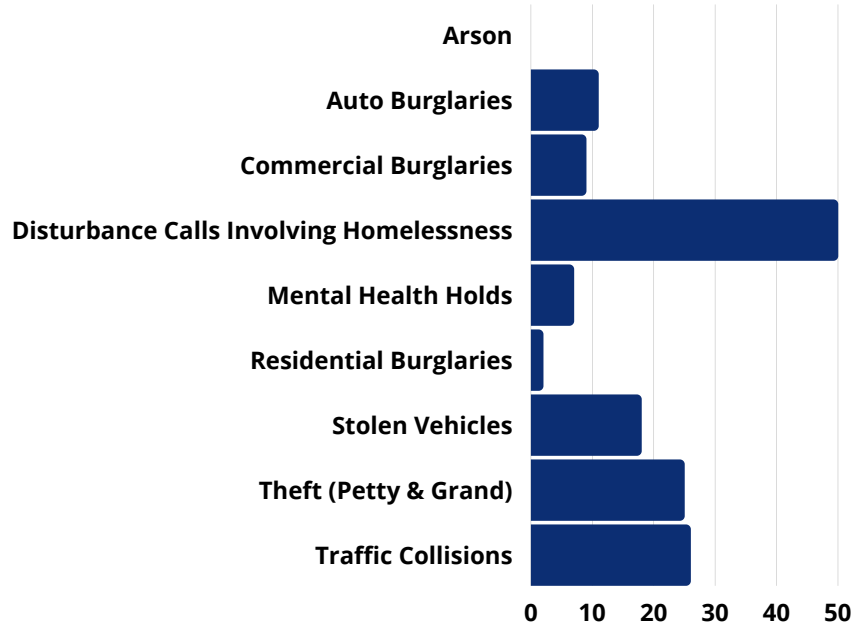


Fremont Police Week In Review
