

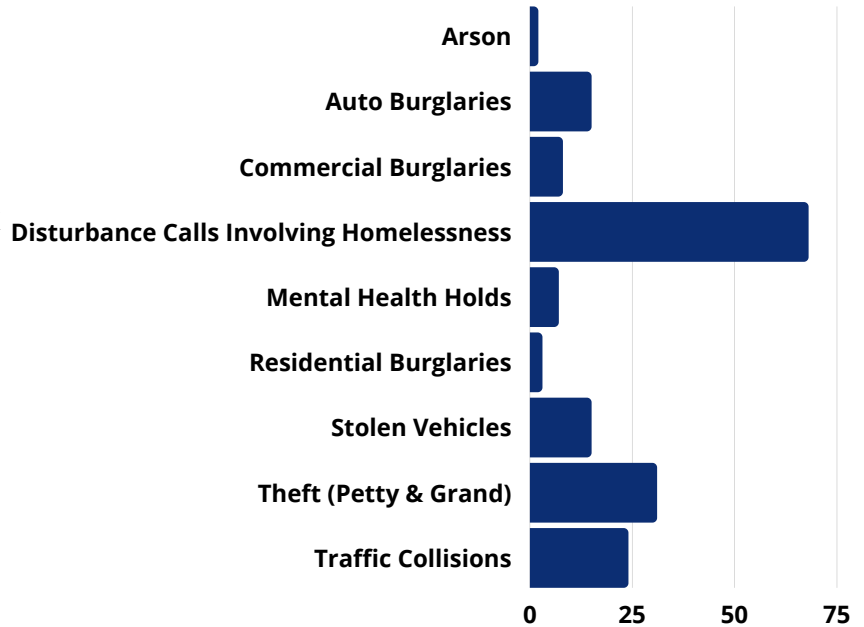


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 04/19 at approximately 3:21 p.m. Fremont police received reports of a fire in the area of the Park Regency Apartments, 39951 Fremont Blvd. A witness advised they could smell smoke and saw a subject running around the parking lot grabbing branches to add to the fire. Jesse Katches (32) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210419024

Auto Theft

On 4/18 at approximately 12:17 p.m. patrol officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Curtis St and Farina Ln. Curtis Montgomery (45) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210418011

Auto Burglary

Brandishing a Weapon

On 4/14, two victims were checking a property in the area of Prune Ave when they encountered a subject with several Amazon packages to the rear of the business. When confronted, the subject reached into his waistband and pulled out a silver handgun. The subject then racked a round into the chamber of the gun and pointed it at the victims. Robbery

On 4/13 at approximately 4:11 p.m. a robbery occurred at 7-Eleven, 494 Mowry Ave. A subject entered the store and attempted to steal alcohol. When the store clerk tried to lock the door to prevent the subject from leaving, he slapped the store clerk across the face. The subject proceeded to leave the store with the items and responding officers located him a short distance away. Eugene Stevens (54) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210413015

Thefts

On 4/13 at approximately 1:15 p.m. a theft occurred in the parking lot of the US Bank, 39390 Fremont Blvd. After exiting the bank, the victim returned to her vehicle and set her purse down on the front seat.
