


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 4/20 at approximately 12:01 a.m. officers responded to reports of a structure fire at Walgreens, 2600 Mowry Ave. The fire appeared to have originated from inside a trash can near the front of the store and caused damage to an exterior wall. A subject was located standing next to the fire and recording it on a cell phone. Germayne Hill (39) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210420001

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/23 at approximately 6:13 p.m. officers responded to a report of a stabbing in the Tesla parking lot, 45500 Fremont Blvd. The victim was stabbed in the leg by a known associate and suffered non-life threatening injuries. Charges are being recommended to the DA for assault with a deadly weapon. #210423023

Auto Theft
