

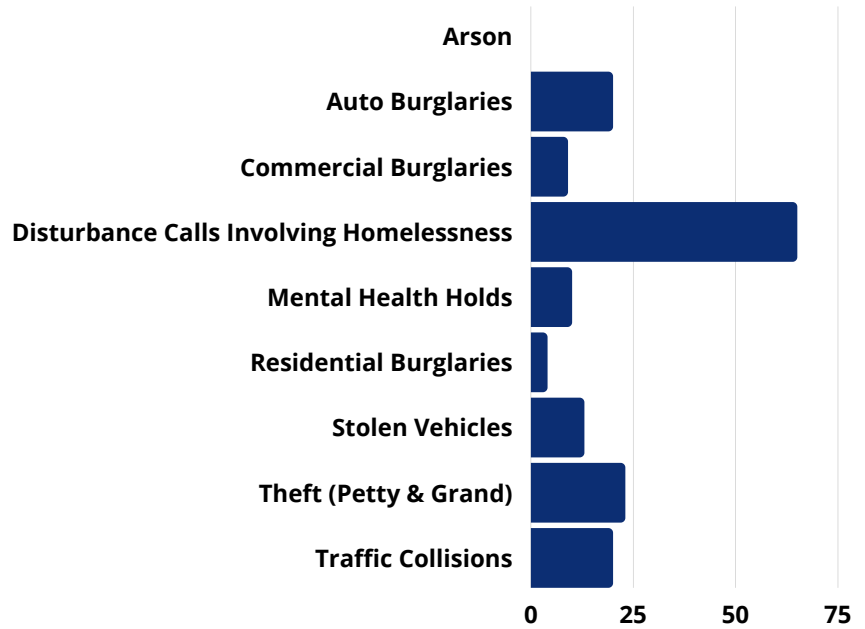

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

Carjacking

On 4/28 at approximately 5:22 p.m. an attempted carjacking occurred in the area of Fremont Blvd and Walnut Ave. The victim was driving in the area when an unknown person jumped in front of her vehicle. The driver's window was rolled down and the person reached inside and demanded the vehicle. The victim was able to drive away and call police. A suspect was tentatively identified and the case was recommended for charging. #210428024
