

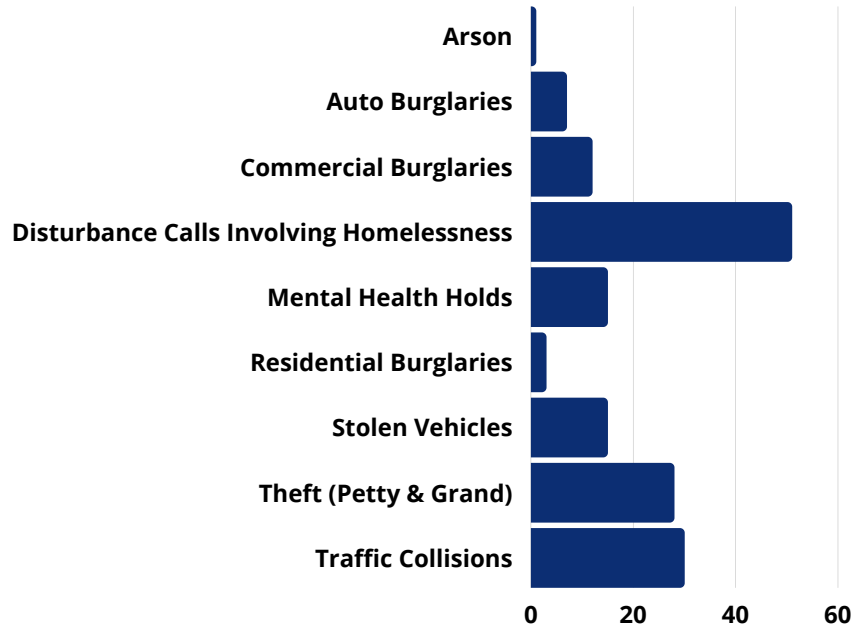

### Auto Burglary

On 5/24 a U.S. Postal mail truck was broken into in the area of Seneca Park Ave and Isle Royal St. A few trays of mail were taken. #210524021

### Auto Theft

On 5/22 at approximately 9:57 p.m. officers located a parked stolen vehicle in the area of Target, 43950 Pacific Commons. Officers contacted the suspect as he returned to the vehicle. Ernesto Salazar (18) out of Fremont was arrested. #210522029

### Commercial Burglary

On 5/19 a commercial burglary occurred at the Amazon Distribution Center, 44109 Pacific Commons. Thousands of dollars' worth of products were stolen. The suspect was identified and some of the loss was recovered from inside his vehicle. Deandre Thurman (29) out of Fremont was arrested. #210519022

Between 5/19 and 5/20, several commercial burglaries occurred at Public Storage, 47209 Warm Springs Blvd. Approximately eighteen storage units were broken into and burglary tools were recovered at the scene. #210520021

## **Residential Burglary**

On 5/19 between 8:44 p.m. and 10:20 p.m. a residential burglary occurred in the area of Orca Tr. Suspect(s) pried open a window to gain access to the residence. #210519038

On 5/21 at approximately 3:45 p.m. a residential burglary occurred in the area of Adobe Dr. Suspect(s) entered the victim's backyard by hopping a rear fence and broke several windows using river rocks to gain access to the residence. #210521024

On 5/23 at approximately 1:31 a.m. a residential burglary attempt occurred in the area of Applegate Tr. The victim noticed via video surveillance that two suspects were in his backyard and called police. Officers arrived on scene and discovered damage to the window screens. ## **Robbery**

On 5/21 at approximately 10:30 a.m. a robbery occurred in the area of Kansas Way and Ursa Dr. An elderly victim was walking in the area when a woman approached her, grabbed her arms, and forcibly removed her jewelry while replacing it with fake jewelry.
