

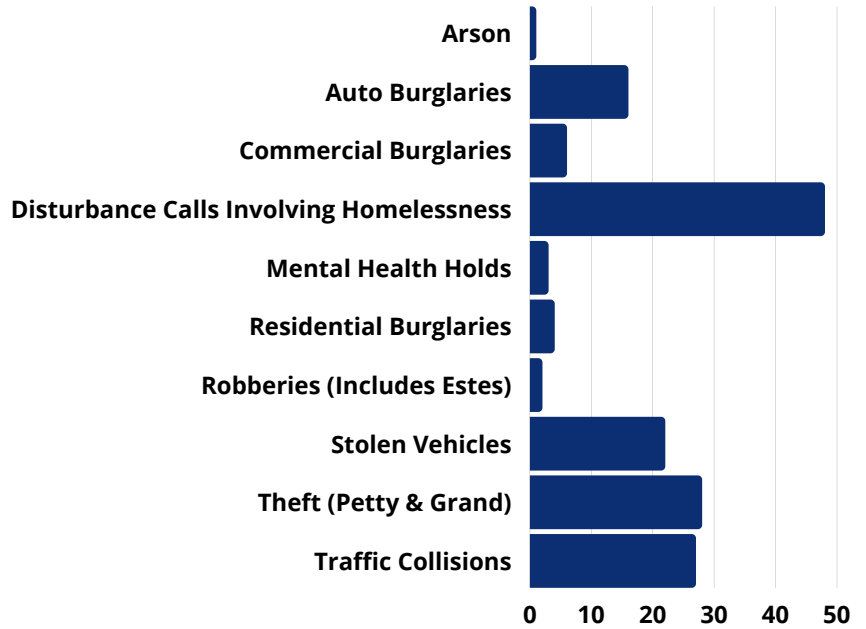


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 5/25 an auto burglary occurred at the Hyatt Place Fremont/Silicon Valley, 3101 W Warren Ave. Suspect(s) shattered a rear window to a vehicle and removed items. #210525011

On 5/26 a U.S. Postal mail truck was broken into in the area of Spady St. A few trays of mail and some packages were taken. #210526016

Auto Theft

On 5/29 at approximately 4:00 a.m. officers located a stolen vehicle at Quik Stop, 38995 Farwell Dr. The suspect was detained near the vehicle, found to be on parole, and had a felony warrant. A search of the vehicle resulted in numerous shaved keys, a controlled substance, and a stun gun. Bryan Wu (31) homeless out of Oakland was arrested. #210529002

Commercial Burglary

On 5/28 at approximately 4:28 a.m. a commercial burglary occurred at OO Liquors, 34460 Fremont Blvd #G. The suspect vehicle backed up to the front door of the business, attached a chain to the front door, and forced entry. The suspect vehicle was still on scene when officers arrived but immediately fled the scene and was not located. It was determined the suspect vehicle was stolen. #210528002

Residential Burglary

Between 5/17 and 5/25 a residential burglary occurred at the Metro Fremont Apartments, 4444 Hansen Ave. Suspect(s) pried open the front door to a residence and ransacked the inside. #210525034

Residential Burglary

Between 5/23 and 5/24 a residential burglary occurred in the area of Capewood Tr. Suspect(s) pried open the rear sliding door to gain access to the residence and removed items. #210525033

On 5/29 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:45 p.m. a residential burglary of a home occurred in the area of Vallejo Mills Park, 37880 Mission Blvd. Suspect(s) entered the residence through a window. #210529017

Robbery

On 5/29 an Estes robbery occurred at Raley's, 39200 Paseo Padre Pkwy. Security contacted a well-known male who was banned from the store and asked him to leave. The male proceeded to "chest bump" security but then left the store. Outside the store, the male took a fighting stance and pulled out a knife. The suspect continued to verbally antagonize security and picked up a 4-foot long piece of metal and swung it towards security. Upon hearing sirens, the suspect fled the scene but was located by officers nearby. Rayvon Taylor (25) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210529023
