

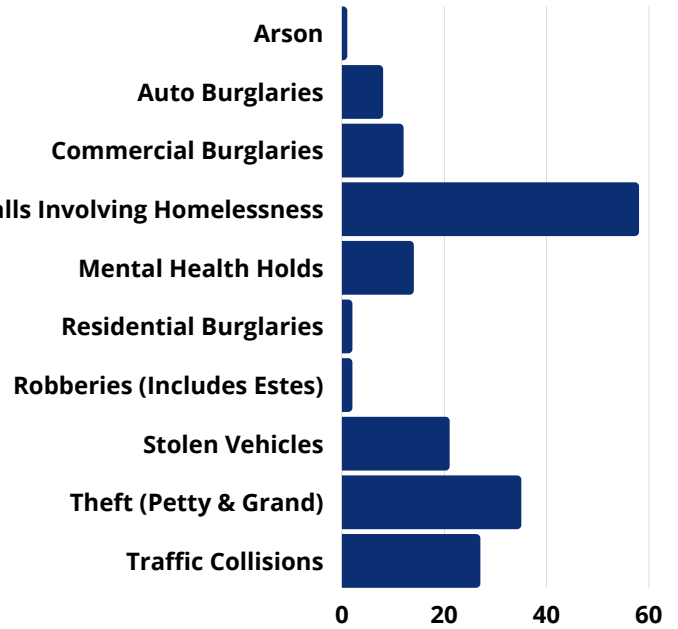


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson
