

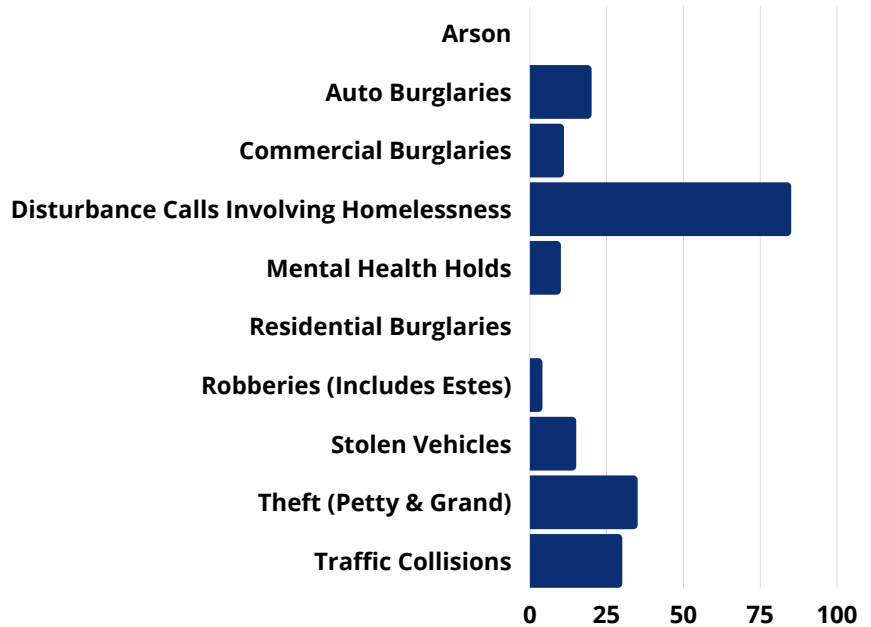


# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Auto Burglary

On 6/25, multiple vehicles were broken into in the area of Paseo Padre Pkwy and Deep Creek Rd. Approximately fifteen reports were taken.

### Auto Theft

On 6/24 at approximately 12:00 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Argonaut Way and Mowry Ave. The suspect parked the vehicle nearby and a high-risk stop was conducted. Brian Whitten (41) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. Whitten was also charged with possession of a controlled substance. #210624017

On 6/26 at approximately 12:37 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Mowry Ave and 880. The vehicle initially fled from officers but was located a short time later at the Waterstone Apartments, 39600 Fremont Blvd. The suspects were located nearby. Estaban Gil (34) out of Fremont and Mario Castillo (31) out of Oakland were both arrested. Additional charges also included possession of burglary tools and methamphetamine. #210626009

### Commercial Burglary

### Reckless Driving

On 6/27 at approximately 12:34 p.m. patrol officers observed a vehicle driving recklessly in the area of Fremont Blvd. Shortly after, the driver lost control of the vehicle and it crashed in the 4000 block of Mowry Ave. The suspect immediately fled and a Good Samaritan quickly tackled the suspect and held him down until additional officers arrived.
