


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 7/01 Officers and Fremont Fire responded to the area of Fremont Blvd and Bidwell Dr after a report of a homeless man starting a fire in the dry brush along the sidewalk. The reporting party extinguished the fire prior to officers arrival. #210701037

On 7/02 Officers responded to the 4200 block of Chetwood Ave; a suspect placed a rag into the fuel cap of the victims truck and lit it on fire. #210702014

Auto Burglary

Between 6/29 - 6/30 two auto burglaries occurred in the parking lot of City Sports, 39153 Farewell Drive. #210629002, #210630021.

Auto Theft
