


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Theft

On 7/26 at approximately 9:59 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Fremont Blvd and Washington Blvd. A high-risk traffic stop was conducted. Stevi Lenning (32) out of Pollock Pines was arrested for the stolen vehicle. Richard Lenning (41) out of Sacramento was arrested for an outstanding felony warrant for attempted murder out of El Dorado County. #210726048

Commercial Burglary

On 7/22 a commercial burglary occurred at Round Tree Apartments, 5749 Birch Tr. A male suspect was observed breaking into the laundry room. A witness called police who responded and located the suspect still inside. Carvel Roque (34) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210722019

Robbery

On 7/20 at approximately 3:54 p.m. a robbery occurred in the area of Cheswycke Tr and Wakerley Tr. Victim was walking with her children when a suspect came up from behind and grabbed her neck. The suspect ripped the victim's necklace off and pushed the victim before fleeing on foot. #210720021

Robbery

On 7/20 at approximately 9:00 a.m. a robbery occurred in the area of King Ave. Victim was walking when she was approached by a suspect holding a small knife. The suspect yelled at the victim, demanding her necklace, and as she fell to the ground, the suspect ripped it off her. The victim sustained a small injury and the suspect fled the area. #210720021

Stabbing

On 7/24 at approximately 12:06 p.m. officers responded to a report of a stabbing. Upon arrival, officers located a victim with multiple stab wounds. Detectives determined the wounds were non-life threatening and inflicted in self defense. William Gunther (37) out of Fremont was arrested for false imprisonment and domestic violence. #210722013

On 7/24 at approximately 9:16 p.m. a stabbing occurred in the area of Papillon Tr. A male suspect showed up to a birthday party with a family member and a fight broke out. The suspect punched and stabbed the victim several times. The victim was treated for non-life threatening injuries. #210724032

Theft

On 7/24 a mail theft occurred at the Redwood Squares Apartments, 47112 Warm Springs Blvd. Multiple mailboxes were broken into. A suspect was identified and the case was sent for charging. #210724009
