

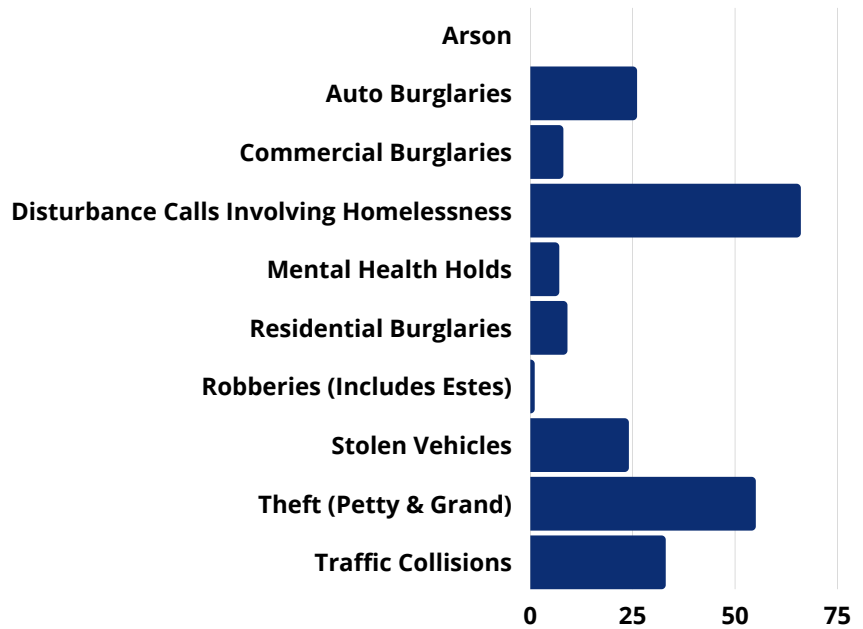


Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault with Deadly Weapon

On 08/04 officers responded to an assault at Ichibox, 43725 Boscell Rd. Two people were at the restaurant when they got into an argument. The victim went outside and was seated on the curb when the suspect began to kick and strike him with a blunt spine of a knife multiple times. The victim was treated for injuries at a local hospital. #210804043

On 08/08 officers responded to a fight at Los Dos Amigos, 41057 Fremont Blvd. Upon arrival officers learned a stabbing occurred. Several people to include the stabbing victim fled the bar. Officers later located them in a car on Stevenson Blvd. The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment and has been uncooperative with the investigation. #210808004

Carjacking

On 8/04 officers responded to multiple calls reporting a man in the area of South Grimmer Blvd/Old Warm Springs Blvd trying to get into occupied vehicles. As Officers responded, the man attempted several carjacking's in the area. One victim had to physically fight the man off and then sped away. Officers attempted to detain the suspect when he advanced towards them and tried to enter a patrol vehicle. During a brief struggle the suspect grabbed an officer's firearm but was unable to remove it. Lincoln Fletcher (23) homeless out of Fremont was arrested for attempted carjacking, resisting arrest, and attempting to disarm a peace officer. #210804036

Commercial Burglary

On 08/05 a commercial burglary occurred at Mission Valley Veterinary Clinic, 55 Mowry Ave. A glass door was smashed to gain entry; various items were taken valuing \$4,000. #210805038

On 08/06 a commercial burglary occurred on Minaret Falls Ter. A fire door was kicked in gaining access to newly constructed homes. #210806008

False Imprisonment

On 08/09 officers responded to a call at Walgreens, 2600 Mowry Ave. Fremont Police Dispatch advised there was a sound of a struggle on the line. The store manager reported hearing a scream and ran to the break room to see a female employee lying on the ground. The manager attempted to open the break room door but the suspect held it shut. Eventually the manager was able to get inside, the suspect then prevented the manager from leaving the office. Officers arrived on scene and took the suspect into custody. Bryan Bullock (35) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210809001

Robbery

On 08/03 a robbery occurred at Ranch 99 Market, 34444 Fremont Blvd. A woman had just finished shopping, she placed her purse on the passenger seat and secured it with a seatbelt. She was sitting in the drivers seat on her phone when a suspect smashed her passenger window and attempted to take her purse. The victim fought over the purse but ultimately the suspect took control and fled. #210803034
