


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 8/17 between 2:39 p.m. and 3:29 p.m. a USPS mail truck was burglarized in the area of Mauna Loa Park Dr. It is unknown how the suspect(s) made entry to the truck and approximately two trays of mail were taken. #210817032

Auto Theft

On 8/17 detectives located a stolen vehicle in the area of Stevenson Blvd and Guardino Dr. The suspect initially attempted to evade officers by driving over a grass embankment. The vehicle was later located in the area of Cabernet Way and the suspect again tried to flee from officers (on foot). Don Rose (42) homeless out of Oakland was arrested. #210817011

Commercial Burglary

Between 8/20 and 8/21 a commercial burglary occurred at Mad Science, 48834 Kato Rd. Suspect(s) shattered a glass door and ransacked the business. #210821006

On 8/20 a commercial burglary occurred at Public Storage, 47209 Warm Springs Blvd. Suspect(s) cut a lock to gain access to a storage unit and removed items. #210821030

Identity Theft

Residential Burglary

On 8/17 at approximately 4:17 a.m. a residential burglary attempt occurred in the area of Maverick Loop. The homeowner witnessed an unknown male attempt to open his sliding door via his doorbell camera. He proceeded to call out to the suspect who immediately fled the area. #210817006

Robbery

On 8/23 at approximately 5:46 a.m. an Estes robbery occurred at CVS, 4020 Fremont Hub. The suspect, who was well-known to staff, entered the store and appeared to be getting ready to take an item. Staff attempted to block the items from being taken and in the process, the staff member was knocked down to the ground. #210823003
