

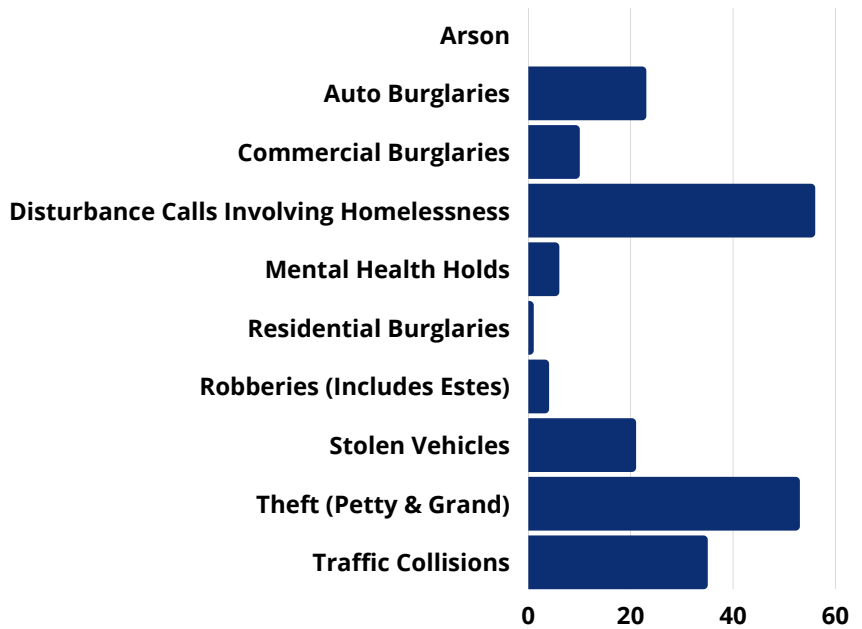


# Fremont Police Week In Review

### Home Invasion

On 8/30 at about 4:30 p.m., officers responded to a home invasion robbery on the 47000 block of Rancho Higuera Rd. A 16-year-old was home alone when he heard banging noises. The victim locked himself in his room and called 911. The suspects kicked open the door and demanded money before fleeing. #210830030

## **Robbery**

On 8/24, a woman was sitting on the curb of the parking lot at 7-11, 39450 Fremont Blvd. A man rode into the parking lot on a scooter, walked up to the woman, and pepper-sprayed her. The man took her bag with her cell phone in it before fleeing. The suspect was located near BART and taken into custody. Carvel Roque (34), homeless out of Fremont, was arrested. #210824007

On 8/29, officers responded to a robbery that occurred at Metro PCS, 37383 Fremont Blvd. Two men entered the store asking to purchase a phone; while the employee retrieved it, they attempted to rob him. The victim fought back; seeing one suspect armed with a handgun, the victim continued to fight and removed the magazine from the firearm. The suspects fled, leaving the victim with injuries. The victim was transported to a local hospital for medical treatment. #210829026
