

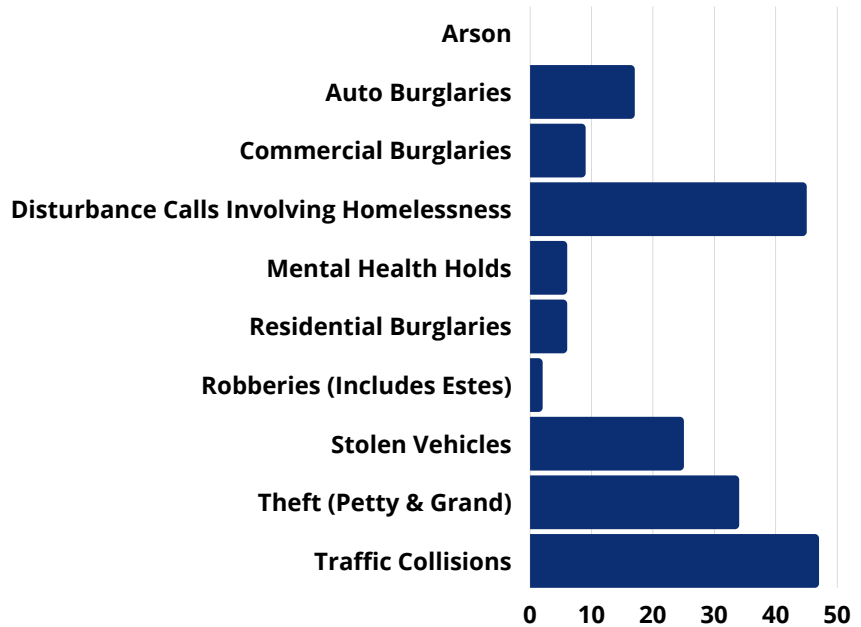


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 9/06, an auto burglary victim called police to advise he was tracking his stolen property and had followed the suspect vehicle to the HUB parking lot, 39281 Fremont Hub. Officers detained two suspects, a piece of the stolen property was recovered. Christopher Warren (41) out of San Jose was arrested. #210906029

Auto Theft

On 8/31 at approximately 12:23 a.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Auto Mall Pkwy and Osgood Rd. Gilberto Medina (33) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210831002

On 8/31 at approximately 6:45 a.m. victims heard their truck start up (which had a dirt bike in the bed) and discovered they were both stolen. Victims drove around the neighborhood looking for their vehicle and located it at the 76 Gas Station, 39925 Mission Blvd. The victim's blocked the vehicle in and the suspect immediately fled on foot. The victim's caught up to the suspect and held him until officers arrived. Oswaldo Sandoval Aquino (31) out of Livingston was arrested. #210831005

On 9/01 at approximately 1:41 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Fremont Blvd and Sundale Dr. Kalia Abbushi (40) out of San Leandro was arrested. #210901024

Residential Burglary

On 9/02 at approximately 2:04 p.m. a residential burglary occurred in the area of Linda Dr. Victim was home when he heard voices in his backyard and then inside his residence. The victim's bedroom door opened and he saw a male holding a wooden stick. The suspect fled the residence and was located a short time later in the area. Daniel Villalobos (27) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #210902015

Between 9/03 and 9/04 a residential burglary occurred in the area of Puttenham Way. Suspect(s) are believed to have made entry through a living room window and removed several items. #210904023

Robbery

On 9/03 at approximately 12:56 p.m. an armed robbery occurred in the area of Fremont Blvd and Chapel Way. The victim was in the area when three suspects approached him, pointed a handgun at him, and demanded his watch and wallet before fleeing the scene. #210903026

On 9/04 at approximately 11:05 a.m. an Estes robbery occurred at Target, 39201 Fremont Blvd. Suspect took items from the store and when confronted by loss prevention, brandished a knife, and a struggle ensued. A suspect was identified and the case was sent for charging. #210904007

Theft

On 9/03 at approximately 12:52 a.m. officers located a vehicle stopped on the street in the area of Logan Dr and Calaveras Ave. A male was seen on the ground, underneath a nearby vehicle. Three suspects were detained and arrested for catalytic converter theft. Phillip Molina (23) homeless out of Milpitas, Luis Vargas (31) homeless out of Fremont and Nicholle Chinn (32) out of Sacramento were arrested. #210903001
