


# Fremont Police Week In Review

## **Auto Burglary**

On 9/21 at approximately 11:30 a.m. an auto burglary occurred at Dennys, 46645 Mission Blvd. Suspect(s) shattered the left front window and removed items. #210921028

On 9/27 two auto burglaries occurred at Starbucks, 46655 Mission Blvd. Suspect(s) shattered the rear passenger windows and removed items. #210927014 & #210927017.

#### **Auto Theft**
