


Fremont Police Week In Review

Arson

On 10/12 an arson occurred at Decorative Plumbing, 4200 Business Center Dr. Suspect was captured on video surveillance lighting paper on fire and placing it in the gas tank of a business truck. Suspect was contacted on scene by officers. Marc Risher (46) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #211012050

Auto Theft

On 10/15 at approximately 1:02 a.m. a stolen vehicle was located in the area of Stevenson Blvd and Interstate 880. Mijamin Middleton (31) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #211015001

Bomb Threat

On 10/18 a business on Warm Springs Blvd received an anonymous email stating a bomb would go off inside the business if they did not receive a \$5,000 payment. The incident was believed to be a "phishing scam". #211018042

Brandishing Weapon

On 10/12 a brandishing weapon incident occurred at 41509 Albrae St. Victim was sitting in her parked vehicle when a male suspect drove up alongside her and said he wanted her phone. The suspect pointed a handgun at her, racked the slide, and said he was going to kill her. Victim was able to get away from the suspect in her vehicle. #211012002

On 10/16 a brandishing weapon incident occurred on Kato Rd. After a road rage incident, the victim and suspect began arguing from their respective vehicles. Suspect then exited his vehicle and pointed a handgun at the victim before leaving the scene. #211016025

Carjacking

On 10/13 a carjacking occurred at 7-Eleven, 42245 Fremont Blvd. Victim was sitting in her vehicle when a male suspect opened her door and pulled the victim out of her vehicle. The victim fled on foot and the suspect proceeded to drive away in the victim's vehicle. The vehicle and suspect were later located. Yosef Alemi (42) homeless out of San Francisco was arrested. #211013028

Robbery

On 10/17 at approximately 5:24 p.m. a robbery occurred at the Wells Fargo ATM, 5191 Mowry Ave. Victim was withdrawing money from the ATM when a male suspect came up from behind. The suspect took the money from the ATM and pushed the victim before fleeing in a vehicle. #211017025
