


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 10/05, approximately three auto burglary occurred at Starbucks, 46655 Mission Blvd. Suspect(s) shattered vehicle windows and removed items. #211005011, #211005012, & #211005013

Auto Theft

On 10/05 at approximately 11:32 a.m. a stolen vehicle was located in the area of Auto Mall Pkwy and Christy St. Meghan Paradis (37) out of Lodi was arrested. #211005023

Commercial Burglary

On 10/06 between 6:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. a commercial burglary occurred at Socome Produce Inc., 3201 Skyway Ct. Suspect(s) cut a cable lock to gain access to the business and removed items. #211008021

On 10/09 between 9:18 p.m. and 10:15 p.m. a commercial burglary occurred at Ramen Arashi, 46577 Mission Blvd. Suspect(s) pried open a rear door and removed items. #211009016

Residential Burglary

On 10/08 at approximately 4:30 a.m. a residential burglary occurred in the area of Webfoot Loop. Victim was home when an unknown suspect climbed a ladder to gain access to a second-floor bathroom window. Suspect opened the bathroom window and the victim heard an object fall. #211008002

Robbery

On 10/05 at 10:15 am an attempted robbery occurred at the Hyatt Place Hotel, 3101 W. Warren Ave. Victim was working in the lot when a male suspect abruptly exited a vehicle and demanded the victim's property. The victim advised he didn't have anything and the suspect proceeded to hit him in the face before fleeing. Detectives later located the suspect vehicle. Robbery

On 10/07 at approximately 5:19 p.m. a robbery occurred at Trader Joe's. 39324 Argonaut Wy. Victim was placing her child inside her vehicle when a male suspect suddenly approached her, grabbed her, and attempted to strike her with a taser. Victim was able to fight off the suspect who then fled in a vehicle. Officers later located the vehicle in the northend of Fremont. Donald Campbell (60) out of Union City was arrested. #211007046

Theft

On 10/08 a grand theft occurred at U-Haul, 44511 S. Grimmer Blvd. Several catalytic converters were taken from vehicles at this location. #211006013
