

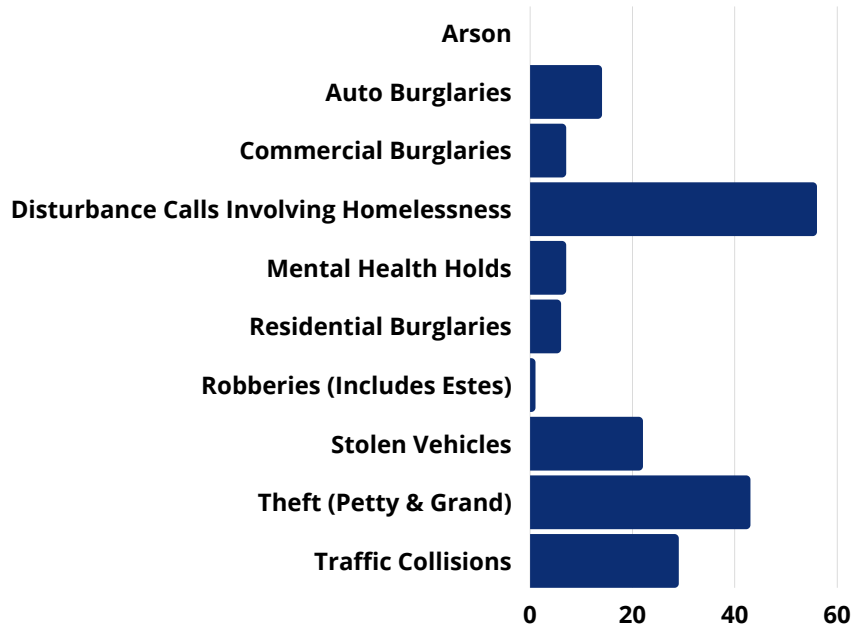


# Fremont Police Week In Review
