

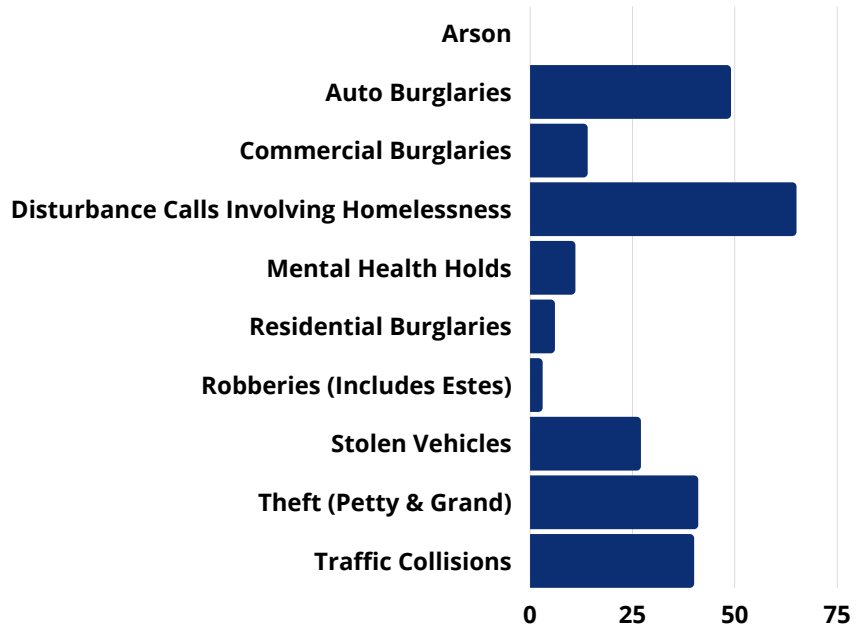


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

Carjacking

On 12/13 at approximately 10:06 p.m. a carjacking occurred at 7-Eleven, 4193 Central Ave. An elderly victim was accosted in the parking lot by two female suspects who then took her vehicle. A short time later, CHP located the vehicle abandoned on the northbound 880 on ramp at Thornton Ave. #211213049

Home Invasion

On 12/10 a approximately 8:06 a.m. a home invasion occurred on Monet Tr. Suspects forced entry into the victim's home, pinned her in the entryway. The suspects took the victim's cell phone and prevented her from leaving until they fled. #211210013

Robbery

On 12/11 at approximately 11:44 a.m. a robbery occurred in the parking lot of 36054 Niles Blvd. Victim was sitting in her vehicle when a female suspect approached her and advised it was her birthday and that she wanted to bless her. The suspect reached into the victim's vehicle and removed her necklace before fleeing in a vehicle.

Theft

On 12/10 at approximately 3:20 a.m. a catalytic convertor theft attempt occurred on Industrial Pl. The victim interrupted the suspect(s) and as they fled the scene, they fired three- four gunshots in the air. #211210007
