

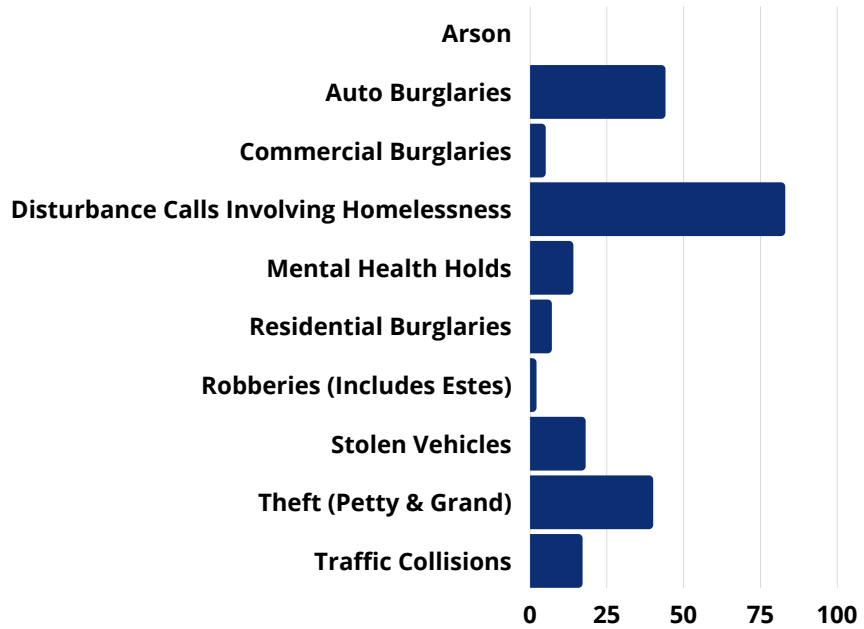


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 12/28 at approximately 4:30 a.m. several auto burglaries occurred in the area of Delaware Dr. Loss was primarily tools. #211228002, #211228003, #211228004, & #211228005.

Carjacking

On 12/29 at approximately 9:13 a.m. a carjacking occurred in the area of Siward Dr. Victim left their vehicle running in front of their residence when a male suspect entered the vehicle and started to drive away. The victim attempted to grab her purse from the vehicle and the suspect threatened to hurt her if she didn't let go of it. Suspect proceeded to flee the scene in the victim's vehicle. #211229010

On 1/02 at approximately 5:27 p.m. a carjacking occurred in the area of Martha Ave and Paseo Padre Pkwy. Victim was attempting to sell her vehicle to someone she met online and arranged to meet with them. After a test drive, the two male suspects pointed handguns at the victim and robbed her of her phone, purse, and vehicle. #220102018

Commercial Burglary
