

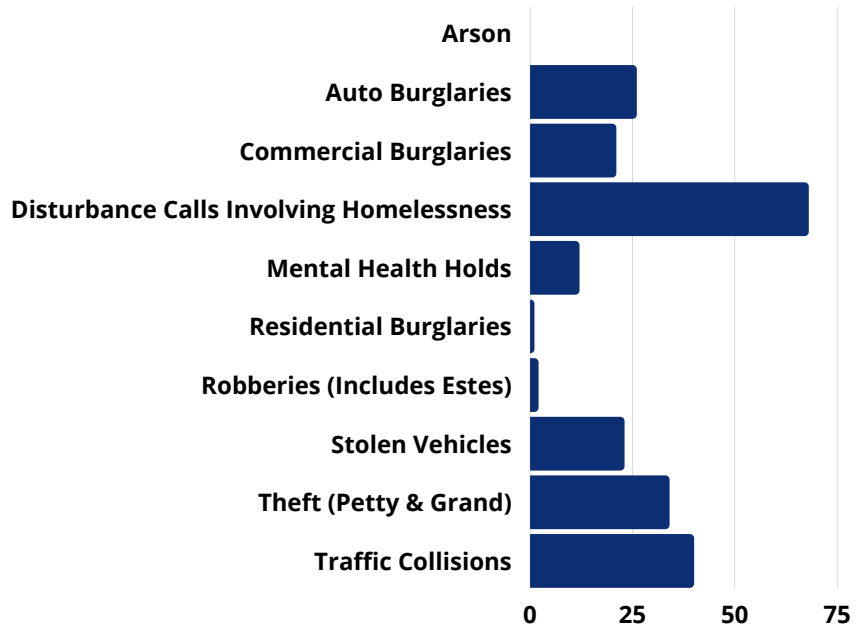


Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 2/8 at approximately 8:04 p.m. an auto burglary occurred in the area of Curie St and Boscell Rd. Suspect(s) shattered the rear driver's side window and removed items. #220208043

Auto Theft

On 2/09 at approximately 3:09 p.m. officers located a stolen vehicle in the area of Auto Mall Pkwy and Osgood Rd. A high-risk vehicle stop was conducted and the driver was detained. Onvjuan Scott (54) out of Fremont was arrested. #220209041

Commercial Burglary

On 2/14 at approximately 3:09 a.m. officers responded to a report of a commercial alarm at 36472 Fremont Blvd. It was determined a commercial burglary had occurred and suspect(s) made entry via glass break. Officers discovered at least two additional businesses had also been burglarized. A witness was able to provide a suspect description and officers quickly located the suspect in the area. Cristian Villegas (26) homeless out of Fremont was arrested. #220214004

Firearm

On 2/10 at approximately 4:45 p.m. officers conducted a vehicle stop in the area of Interstate 880 and Thornton Ave. It was determined the driver had a felony warrant and was detained. A search of the vehicle yielded a loaded firearm. Ronald Walker (39) out of Castro Valley was arrested. #220210042

Residential Burglary

On 2/09 at approximately 1:00 p.m. a residential burglary occurred at the Presidio Apartments, 2000 Walnut Ave. Two suspects entered the complex and took a package from the storage locker area. #220211014

Robbery

On 2/11 at approximately 10:20 p.m. a robbery occurred at Jack in the Box, 5533 Stevenson Blvd. Victim was accosted in the parking lot by two male suspects, causing him to fall to the ground. The suspects took the victim's personal belongings and fled in a vehicle. # 220211048

On 2/14 at approximately 4:21 p.m. a robbery occurred at Lucky, 34101 Fremont Blvd. A male suspect entered the store with a gun in his waistband and placed a note on the counter. The suspect's note demanded money and stated he would shoot everyone in the store. The suspect quickly left the store with the note after the robbery. #220214033

Theft

On 2/08 at approximately 2:12 a.m. a catalytic converter theft attempt occurred in the area of Cottonwood St. A witness awoke to a sawing noise and quickly went outside to find two suspects near a Toyota Prius, holding a catalytic converter. The witness was able to grab the catalytic converter back from the suspects as they attempted to flee in a vehicle. #220208008

On 2/11 at approximately 2:00 p.m. a grand theft occurred at Walgreens, 2600 Mowry Ave. Two male suspects left the store with over \$1,000 worth of unpaid items. Officers located the suspects in the area and recovered the stolen merchandise. Theodore Melicia (35) out of Seaside and Bradley Stavas (34) out of San Francisco were arrested. #220211032
